Important Ski/Snowboard Club Information:

<u>Season passes:</u> Families can purchase 6 Week Program Passes by going to the Wachusett Mountain website and clicking on Tickets & Passess, then choosing School Groups. Or you can go there directly to www.wachusett.com/schoolgroups. Once there you will need to type in the special Narragansett Ski/Snowboard Club code which is **NTSCH**. **Please note that this is the same code as last year**. From here you can choose from a variety of options for purchasing passes and rentals. Parents can start ordering program services from October 2, 2024 until December 1, 2024. You can still order passes from December 2 until December 13 but the price will

increase. The very last day to order a pass will be December 13, 2024.

Parents Step ONE: Sign up with Coordinator and pay the bus fee (if applicable) in

order to receive the program code.

Parents Step TWO: Go to wachusett.com/schoolgroups

Parents Step THREE: Enter this code: NTSCH to access your program's form. If a student already has a Season Pass, there will be a check box during ordering to select that they already purchased a pass.

<u>Who's eligible:</u> Students in 5th grade and up. Family members are eligible if participating in Recreation Department and YMCA programs. Although younger students are eligible, they must be accompanied by an adult. Even though there will be chaperones, students must be comfortable enough to ski on their own or have a parent or guardian with them.

Best time to purchase: Anyone can purchase passes from October 2 until Dec 1st, for best pricing *QUANTITIES LIMITED. Last day to order will be Dec. 13.

MORE FOR YOUR MONEY • \$5 COW Card Bonus -- Purchase a \$50 gift card for only \$45. Card is valid for food, MTNside Ski & Ride Shop and more. If lost, there is a \$5 replacement fee – Wachusett Mountain will replace remaining value on a new card.

<u>6 Week Program:</u>START Date for the 6 week sessions starts Monday, January 6, 2025. (**No program Jan. 20, 2024 or Feb. 17-21, 2025**). The program will not run if school gets canceled on any of the Monday's for any reason (snow days and holidays)

<u>Transportation:</u> Due to limited seating on the school vans, we will only be able to transport 23 students on a first come, first served basis. Once the 23 spots have been filled we will not be able to provide transportation for more students. The ski/snowboard club can accept more than 23 students to join, but they will need to find their own transportation both to and from the mountain. BADGE INSURANCE • Provides Student Badge Replacement at a pro-rated refund if unable to use services due to unforeseen circumstances. Must be purchased when badge is ordered. • Pass Assurance - Any Student Badge purchased this season qualifies for a CREDIT or DEFERRAL.

Equipment • Renting—Rental Packages (include skis/poles/boots or snowboard/boots) are available for your program days OR full season. Rental equipment for use at Wachusett only. •Bringing your own ski gear— Ski and Snowboard equipment should be marked with NAME, SCHOOL, AND PHONE NUMBER.

Lessons • Lessons for beginners and novice (Levels 1-4), are required. (Limited Space Available) (See Class Level description when ordering the lesson online.) • First Time Students CANNOT start after the first program day. If you're a "First-timer," it may take one or more sessions to learn the skills needed for lift serviced terrain.

Base Lodge Capacity: There will be strict capacity regulations in the base lodge with more details to follow, please help us adhere to the rules and inform you students of the changes before the program begins. We encourage students to leave personal items in the vehicle they travel in and NOT bring anything into the lodge.

Program Day: MONDAY - Starts Monday, January 6, 2025.

Pickup Time: 3:00PM in front of the high School- Only applies to 23 students who secure transportation in the vans.

Arrival Time: 3:30PM Anyone involved with the ski/snowboard club must be at Mt Wachusett Ski Area by this time, so we can submit our attendance list. If you are getting your own ride to and from the mountain, you will need to let me know if you are coming by 3:00PM each day of the trip.

Lesson Time: 5:00P - Anyone who signed up for lessons will need to be with their instructors by this time. If you need more information about where to meet, please contact Mr Donofrio.

Departure Time: 7:00PM - Anyone student being transported in the van will need to be at the van, ready to leave by 7:00PM. This is extremely important!!

Program Type: 6 Weeks

WEATHER CONDITIONS: Our programs run in almost all weather conditions. Mt Wachusett will call us by noon on our scheduled day if the ski area has to close for any unforeseen circumstances. However, Narragansett ski/snowboard club may need to cancel scheduled trips to the mountain due to dangerous driving conditions (snowdays) or other problems.
