

# Crochet Rice Dumpling Amigurumi



## Supplies & Tools

Yarn	<a href="#">4-ply Combed Cotton Yarn - 11g</a>
Hook	3.0mm
Size	7 x 7 x 8 cm

## Abbreviations

CH	Chain
HDC	Half Double Crochet
INC	Increase
MR	Magic Ring

SC	Single Crochet
SS	Slip Stitch
* A * x B	Repeat "A" for a number of B times
( x )	Work all of "x" in ONE stitch

## Gauge

8 stitches x 9 rows of Single Crochets = 1"

## Pattern

This dumpling consists of 2 different types of triangles.

First, the isosceles triangle, where 2 sides of the triangle have equal length.

Sides {isosceles triangle} x 3



Round	Stitches	Count
1	CH 3, HDC in first CH	2
2	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, INC in last stitch	4

3	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 2 HDC, INC in last stitch	6
4	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 4 HDC, INC in last stitch	8
5	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 6 HDC, INC in last stitch	10
6	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 8 HDC, INC in last stitch	12
7	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 10 HDC, INC in last stitch	14
8	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 12 HDC, INC in last stitch	16
9	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 14 HDC, INC in last stitch	18
10	CH 2, HDC in same stitch, 16 HDC, INC in last stitch	20

### Base {equilateral triangle}



Round	Stitches	Count
1	Begin with 3 SC in MR	3
2	(4 SC) in each stitch	12
3	2 SC, *(4 SC), 3 SC* x 2, (4 SC), SC	21

4	4 SC, *(4 SC), 6 SC* x 2, (4 SC), 2 SC	30
5	6 SC, *(4 SC), 9 SC* x 2, (4 SC), 3 SC	39
6	8 SC, *(4 SC), 12 SC* x 2, (4 SC), 4 SC	48
7	10 SC, *(4 SC), 15 SC* x 2, (4 SC), 5 SC	57
8	12 SC, *(4 SC), 18 SC* x 2, (4 SC), 6 SC	66

Attach the sides to the base by SS or sewing, then sew the sides shut.

The rice dumpling can absolutely be made of all equilateral triangles as the stitches are tighter and apt for amigurumi but I personally find that the equilateral triangle consumes more yarn and the stiffer and spiral look is not what I exactly go for. The darker green one is made of all equilateral triangles for your reference.

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
