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Mad Science: Adventures in Electricity**

Join us for an exciting adventure into the fascinating world of science. This camp is designed to spark curiosity, foster critical thinking, and inspire a lifelong love of science in children in grades K-5.

They learn how tiny invisible particles—electrons—power everything from the fridge to the radio.
