The bean bounty continues and cukes are back after a brief hiatus (while they were replaced by their sweeter cousins-the melons). We finally have enough smaller sized watermelons beginning to ripen. We hope to include them in all the shares over the next couple of weeks.

The share will be: kale, lettuce, peppers, beets, squash, cucumbers, beans, scallions, red fingerling potatoes, tomatoes, basil, and watermelon (as supplies last). Premium shares will also include shishito peppers and broccolini. There will be hot peppers and okra as extras.
