



Participate in TheDream.US Internship Funding Program and/or TheDream.US Experiential Fellowship Program

INTERNSHIP FUNDING PROGRAM

Brief Overview: TheDream.US, in partnership with its Partner Colleges, will provide internship funds for current TheDream.US Scholars with a SSN or ITIN.

- Partner Colleges are responsible for promoting and managing Internship Funding Program to their Scholars and Host Organizations
 - Ensure internship abides by TheDream.US Program Guidelines
 - Find and secure internship opportunities via (1) Scholars Find Unpaid Internships and/or (2) PC works with Host Organizations on- or off-campus to develop internships
 - Know how Scholars, Host Orgs, and PCs use Parker Dewey to post, apply, and track applications
- Each PC will need to identify 2 staff/faculty members as Program Point of Contacts
- Each PC can receive up to \$15,000* per Program Year from TheDream.US (subject to funding)

Steps to Participate in TheDream.US Internship Funding Program:

1. Review [Internship Program's Concept Paper](#)
2. Determine a Primary Program Point of Contact (POC) and a Secondary Program POC
 - a) Required: At least 1 POC must be a TheDream.US Liaison (i.e. Scholar Advisor, Career Liaison, etc.)
3. Primary POC completes [PC Internship Funding Program Participation Application](#) by **EOD Fri, Dec 4**
4. Within 1 Week of Submitting Application: Kickoff Email will be sent to Primary and Secondary POC
5. Once Kickoff Email is received, PC will be asked to schedule a mandatory program overview meeting with a TheDream.US contact. After this meeting, PC can start promoting this program.

EXPERIENTIAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

Brief Overview: TheDream.US, in partnership with its Partner Colleges, will provide fellowship funds for current TheDream.US Scholars with a SSN or ITIN.

- Partner Colleges are responsible for creating*, running, and managing all aspects of Fellowship Program (and abides by TheDream.US Program Guidelines)
- Each PC needs to craft a Concept Paper outlining your inclusive fellowship program
- Each PC will need to identify 2 staff/faculty members as Program Point of Contacts
- Each PC can receive up to \$15,000* per Program Year from TheDream.US (subject to funding)

**PCs who already have an existing inclusive fellowship program – or want to expand upon an existing fellowship program to make it inclusive, are also eligible to participate in this program.*

Steps to Participate in TheDream.US Experiential Fellowship Program:

1. Review [Fellowship Program's Concept Paper](#)
2. Determine a Primary Program Point of Contact (POC) and a Secondary Program POC
 - a) Required: At least 1 POC must be a TheDream.US Liaison (i.e. Scholar Advisor, Career Liaison, etc.)
3. Craft a 1-2 Concept Paper outlining your Program (this will be uploaded as part of application)
4. Primary POC completes [PC Fellowship Program Participation Application](#) by **EOD Friday, Dec 4**
5. Within 1 Week of Submitting Application: Kickoff Email will be sent to Primary and Secondary POC
6. Once Kickoff Email is received, PC will be asked to schedule a mandatory program overview meeting with a TheDream.US contact. After this meeting, PC can start promoting this program.

**Funds are not disbursed directly to Partner College. Funds are transferred from TheDream.US to Parker Dewey, who manages disbursement of funds to Scholars.*
