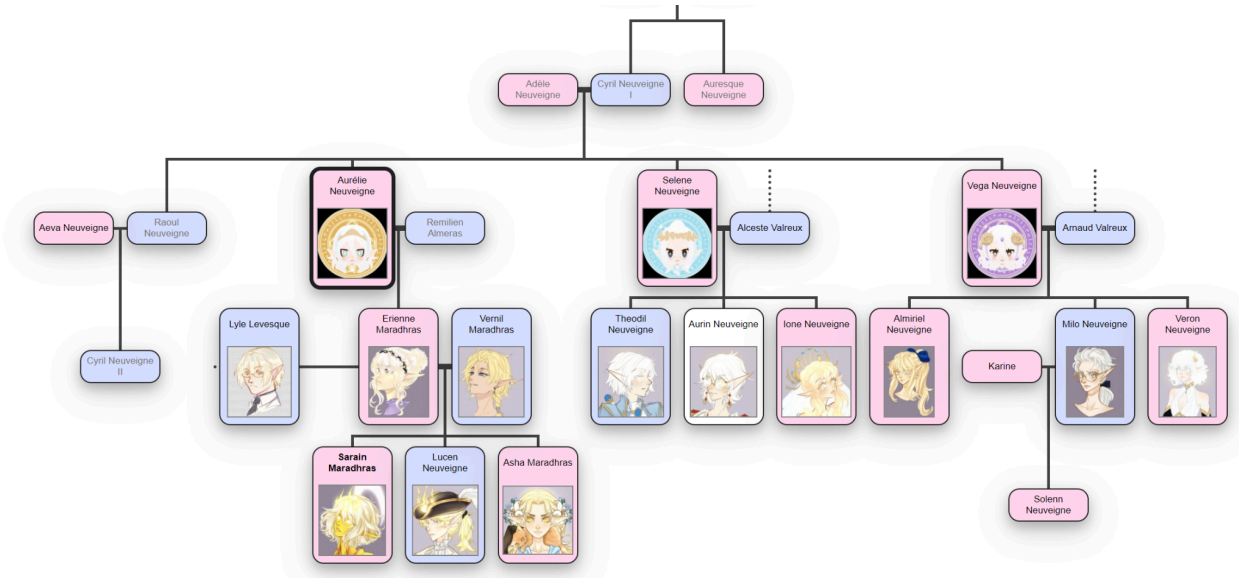

Cyril Neuveigne de Caelora I

Occupations: Deceased Vidame of Caelora
Class: Wizard

Occupations: Deceased Vidame of Caelora
Class: Wizard

Both a Vidame and an officer in Delverne's Navy, Raoul was respected during the time he held power. Though more aloof with the people than his son, the region saw a steady increase in prosperity under his guidance for his distinguished military service and generous donations to the church. He was lost at sea at age 204 and the responsibility of Vidame was passed to his son, Cyril II.

Occupations: Deceased Vidame of Caelora

Class: Sorcerer

Son of the previous Vidame, Raoul. Cyril inherited his title at the young age of 54 and was Vidame for 11 years before succumbing to illness. Suffering from thymagea, he had a sickly constitution but he was known for his kindness and is thought of affectionately after his passing. He excelled at his religious studies and gave several uplifting sermons in the years before his illness began to take a toll, and the family was hopeful he would fill the shoes of a higher Church-affiliated office.

Occupations: Vidamesse of Caelora

Class: Wizard [Light, Lightning]

With the passing of her elder brother and his heir, the mantle fell to her and she wore it with grim determination. She had been close with her brother and nephew, and their passing hardened her heart. Her only daughter, Erienne, embarrassed her family when she renounced her inheritance and eloped with a low-born man, so it came as a surprise to everyone when the Vidamesse sought out her grandson Lucen to groom into her heir. Deep down, she seeks to reconcile with the family she pushed away and is trying to bring her wayward children and grandchildren home, one by one.

Class: Sorcerer [Lightning, Light]

The new heir to the vidamie grew up in a humble seaside farming village in southern Delverne, totally unaware of his own noble lineage. Competitive, a quick learner and ambitious, he is likewise inelegant, bull-headed and rough around the edges. Vidame Jean Belrose has taken him on as a squire, and his strict no-nonsense approach to teaching is proving much more effective than Theodil's gentle, guiding hand. While he harbors plenty of animosity at the return of his elder sister, he has nevertheless taken on the burden of catching her up to speed on proper etiquette around Delverne's elite, if only to keep her from embarrassing their family further.

Under Milo's command, they travel around the vidamie to oversee and manage internal affairs personally; a duty he continues to perform while Lucen is in training with the Templars, and now off to war at Aurea's side. Etiquette and protocol are deeply ingrained in him, and he usually acts as the mediator or voice of diplomacy where his family is concerned. Theo stepped back gracefully when Lucen came to claim his inheritance, and currently corresponds regularly with the new heir to offer his advice as he trains with the Belroses.

Class: Wizard [Lightning, Air]

It's no surprise to anyone that Selene plans on passing the Academy to them. They have admirable drive and passion, but can be singularly focused, narrow minded and tend to let their temper get the better of them. Aurin is probably the most insulted by their brother being passed over in favor of Lucen's arrival, and enjoys riling up the lad and keeping him on his toes. Because of this, they tend to butt heads a lot with Ione. They are a fearsome socialite who enjoys attending parties and putting people on the spot. It is for this reason that they were charged with teaching their cousin Veron the intricacies of interpersonal interactions.

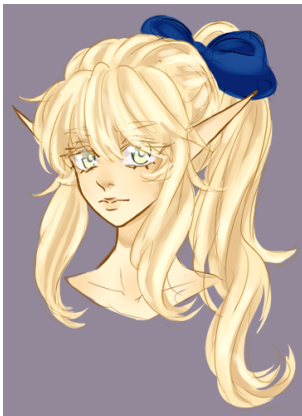
Vega Neuveigne de Turelle ²⁶¹

Occupations: High Priestess of the Spire Cathedral → Ascended

Class: Wizard

A beauty of great renown, she is every bit as shrewd as her sisters. While considered a wildcard in her youth, age has seen her become more mellow around the edges - though she still retains her more free spirited attitude. She's never quite seen eye to eye with stern, solemn Aurelie but tensions came to a head when the Vidamesse sought out Lucen as her heir rather than Theo or even her own son, Milo. She is quite close with Ione, lamenting often how her own children lack an appreciation for the finer aspects of life. When Aurea called for her most faithful, Vega answered, believing it to be her life's purpose.

Occupations: Oathbound Templar Knight → **Ascended**

Class: Paladin

The elder of the Neuveigne twins, she takes after her father Arnaud Valreux in both appearance and aspiration and is one of the few members of the family who has not pursued the path of a Wizard, despite their objections and pressure. Instead she serves as a Templar alongside him. She has taken the Oath in place of her brother, who would have taken it in exchange for asking Aurea to heal his daughter.

Class: Wizard [Lightning, Light]

The younger of the Neuveigne twins. He's an officer in Delverne's navy, and is the official captain of the Dawnbreaker. The eldest of his wizardly cousins, he's had his fair share of tutoring each of them, and will mellowly reminisce fond stories of all the embarrassing things they've done if he sees them flaunting any sort of ego. He's also a family man, though his young daughter Solenn is an unfortunate victim of thymagea. He is wed to Karine Neuveigne nee (Blank).

The newest member of the Neuveigne family. She's currently very sheltered, as she suffers from thymagea - the same affliction Sarain had as a child.

Occupations: Student

Class: Wizard [Water, Air]

As a Neuveigne, to be prodigious in magic was expected. Even so, Veron's prowess threatens to surpass expectations. However, where she excels in performance she lacks in persona; stoic and asocial, Veron's interests lay far outside the realm of politics and socializing. She's never been able - or interested - in making friends among her peers and her bluntness often offends others and pushes them away. Thus, her mother has placed her under Aurin's supervision, much to the chagrin of both cousins, in hopes that she may learn a thing or two about politics before the end of the century.

RELATED NOBILITY

Almeras

The Almeras family owns a baronie at the fringes of the Neuveignes' vidamie, and as traditional healers both sides saw benefits to the marriages that united their families. In exchange for allowing themselves to become encompassed by the Neuveignes and achieving higher nobility, they provided easy access to reliable healers. The Almeras family was allowed to retain many aspects of their autonomy under the Neuveignes' banner, and for their service they have become favored to them.

Occupations: Family Healer

Class: Exorcist

Wife to Raoul Neuveigne, a previous Vidame, and mother to Cyril Neuveigne, the Vidame immediately prior to Aurelie's succession. Raoul was an officer in Delverne's navy, and was lost at sea to northern pirates. Cyril was born with a multitude of health problems as well as suffering from thymagea, and he inherited the Vidame title immediately after his father's passing. His time as head of the family was short, however, and he eventually succumbed to illness. Though heartbroken by their passings, Aeva continues to remain with the Neuveigne family, and she is well taken care of and respected in return.

Remilien Almeras Age

Occupations: Baron

Class: Cleric

Deceased husband to Aurelie Neuveigne. Their relationship was cold but civil all the way until the day of his passing. She has since taken over his baronie directly with his passing.

Valreux

A Knight family of gentry status, they merged with the Neuveignes as a calculated measure to combat the growing frailty prevalent in their family members. They have a long history of distinguished service with the Templars, and to the vidamie as well.

Arnaud Valreux ³⁰⁰

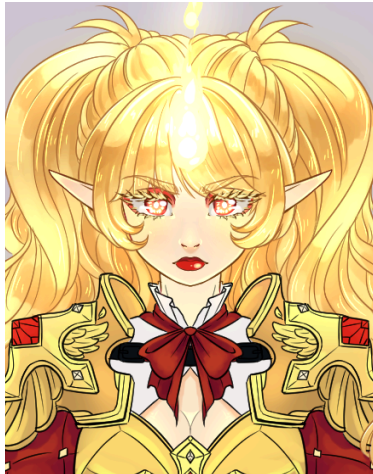

Class: Champion

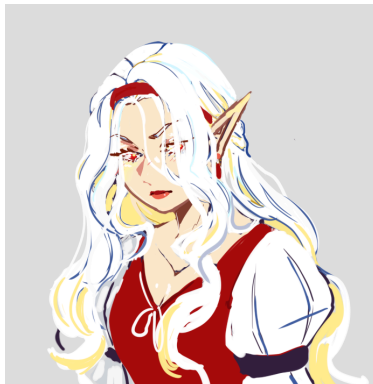
Younger brother to Arnaud. Took the Oath as well.

FABLED ANCESTORS

Nersillus the Arrogant

One of the most powerful wizards in the history of the Neuveignes, however that's not what he was remembered for. The family's decline is generally blamed on him and his folly for he wielded his power with such arrogance that he renounced needing the Church and Aurea herself, claiming he was more powerful than either. He was eventually consumed by his own madness after he tried to raise his personal tower study into the sky as a symbol of his perceived status over everyone else, only for Aurea's divine might to send it crashing to the bottom of the ocean. The ripple effects of his hubris plagued the family for centuries after his death. Speaking of him is generally taboo, but all in the family know his story so they may not repeat his mistakes.
