Athletic Eligibility Requirements (from CMS Handbook)

Students will abide by the participation in extracurricular policy as adopted by the RSU 87 school board. As reflected in that policy, academic achievement, habits of learning, attendance and appropriate student conduct are necessary in order to be eligible for participation.
