Typical progression through ranks with plans for working on Eagle-required merit badges at meetings and camp. "Years" run ~March – February to reflect crossover timing and time in troop. Scouts can and will go at their own pace; this is a plan that incorporates troop meetings and the progression of age-appropriate activities and merit badges. The numbers in parentheses indicate cumulative Eagle Required Merit Badges.

Year 1

- 5th grade-Spring Complete Scout rank, begin and/or complete Tenderfoot (TF)
- 1st Year Summer Camp Finish TF, Outdoor 2c & 1c reqs (First Year Camper program), NRMB as time permits.
- 6th grade-Fall/Winter 2c Indoor, finish 2c for January COH

Year 2

- 6th grade-Winter/Spring 1c Indoor, finish 1c for June COH.
- Once First Class is completed, meet w/ counselor and start looking at completing req's for Cooking and Camping MB on campouts and at summer camp.
- 2nd Year Summer Camp Finish 2c, 1c if needed. Swimming, First Aid MB (2), NRMB
- 7th grade-Fall/Winter Star regs, Communications MB (host January COH) (3)

Year 3

- 7th grade-Winter/Spring Cit Community (4), Star rank
- 3rd Year Summer Camp EVS/Sustainability, Lifesaving/Emergency Preparedness MB (6), NRMB, intro to High Adventure (age/size/skill appropriate)
- 8th grade-Fall/Winter Life regs, Cit Nation (7)

Year 4

- 8th grade-Winter/Spring Cit World (8), Life rank
- 4th Year Summer Camp Camping, Cooking (10), NRMB, ATV/Jet Ski, High Adventure
- 9th grade-Fall/Winter Independent: Personal Fitness, Personal Management, Family Life

Year 5 and beyond

- 9th grade-Winter/Spring Independent: PF, PM, FL (13)
- 5th Year Summer Camp Wrap up any incomplete ERMB, NRMB, ATV/Jet Ski, High Adventure
- 10th grade Fall/Winter and beyond Wrap up any incomplete ERMB, Eagle Project
