Module Outcome Summary & Metrics

Our first STEM Module focused on Info-tech, Cyber Security & AI was a great success, per the below metrics we were able to achieve. This module opened opportunities for extended partnership with the NYPD Community Affairs – Explorers Program, mentee recruitment from the NYPD Housing Authority, as well as with Google Code Next.

Mentees

- Our preregistration list included 62 mentees
- Our actual module attendance comprised of 34 mentees, 7 volunteer mentors, and several NYPD volunteers:

Mentees:

- 30 new kids of which 28 signed up to the Leadership and Life Skills Mentorship Program through our online platform.
- 4 returning mentees

NYPD Youth Recruitment

We are happy to report that **20** of our new mentees were recruited from the NYPD and their youth programs:

- Explorers Program
- NYPD Housing Authority Police Service Area 5
- Brooklyn Community Center

All **34** mentees in attendance were exposed to the Google Code Next lab in Manhattan and were briefed on their program for high school students. Mentees were able to see and speak with Google Code Next coaches and their facility manager.

18 mentees are interested in learning more about the Google Code Next Program – and are confident about signing up!

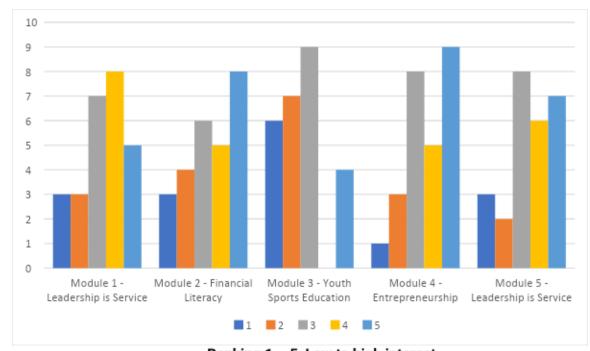
Mentee Feedback
