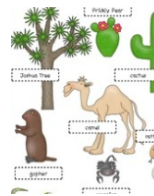
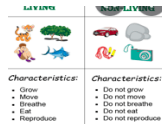


Chamber and Fox Class Mission Homework – Spring B 2026
