Just a friendly reminder to be sure to submit your GSoC Final Evaluation and Work Product URL before the Monday, August 23 18:00 UTC deadline on your GSoC <u>dashboard</u> if you haven't already. So far about 30% of students have submitted their evals with their work product URL.

You are almost done with GSoC but to successfully complete the program you must submit your Final Evaluation and Work Product URL following your mentor's instructions (if they gave you specific instructions) and the <a href="Work Product Submission Guidelines">Work Product Submission Guidelines</a>.

We realize you are probably still putting the final touches on your work which is fine, but please don't wait until the last few hours to submit all of your work. You've worked very hard for the past 3 months, please don't miss this deadline and receive an automatic fail because your internet goes down, your computer breaks, you get sick, etc. over the last few days of the program.

#### Important Upcoming Deadlines

**August 23 18:00 UTC**: Deadline to submit your code and your evaluation of your mentor. Do not wait until the last minute to submit, if you miss the deadline your projet will be failed. *Be sure to communicate with your mentor* as they will likely require you to merge your code sooner than this deadline so they can evaluate your work.

Mentor evaluations of students begin August 23. All work must be submitted before August 23 at 18:00 UTC. Anything submitted after that will not be considered in your mentor's evaluation of your work.



# Final Code Submission and Evaluations now open (due Monday, Aug 23 before 1800 UTC)

You've made it to the final stretch of GSoC 2021, congratulations! You are in the final days of your GSoC 2021 experience, great job! You've spent the last 10 weeks working on your project and now it's time to wrap it all together for final review from your mentor.

At this point your project should be nearly complete. By now you should have already read the <u>Work Product Submission Guidelines</u> and discussed with your mentor how you will submit your work for them to preview before you submit your final evaluation which includes providing the link to your work product on your <u>dashboard</u>.

Be sure to complete your Final Evaluation **before Monday, August 23rd at 18:00 UTC**. You can access it now from your <u>dashboard</u>. This is a required part of your GSoC participation and cannot be changed after submission.

Remember, completing this Final Evaluation is more involved than the first evaluation - <u>do not</u> <u>wait until the last minute to complete the evaluation</u>. All students must complete their Final Evaluation before the deadline or they will fail GSoC.

Starting August 23rd at 18:01 UTC, Mentors will be completing Final Evaluations of students and making pass/fail decisions.

# Be sure to follow these 3 final steps (in order) before August 23rd at 18:00 UTC.

Start now! Don't wait until the last minute. This will take you a while to complete all 3 steps.

- 1. Read the Work Product Submission Guidelines
- 2. Discuss with your mentor how you will submit your work and send them a preview as soon as possible.
  - a. This is important because if your link is broken (not pointing to the correct code, etc.) you will have time to fix it before you submit your Final Evaluation. You don't want to submit a bad link and fail GSoC because of it.

- b. Do not miss the deadline because you haven't heard back from your mentor after submitting a preview. If you do not hear back from your mentor by **August 22nd** at 18:00 UTC submit your evaluation anyway. A missed evaluation means an automatic fail.
- 3. Submit your Final Evaluation before August 23rd at 18:00 UTC.
  - a. If you go to your <u>dashboard</u> you can now access the Final Evaluation. This is a required part of your GSoC participation. The first question asks you to submit the URL pointing to your Work Product for GSoC 2021. This will be shown to your mentor to use in their final evaluation decision and will be displayed on the public GSoC site of successful projects. You can preview the final evaluation questions here.
  - b. Once you submit your Final Evaluation you can not edit it.

## Receiving the Final Stipend

If you receive a passing evaluation on your final evaluation you will receive your stipend by August 31.

Work Product Submission Guidelines

Be sure to discuss with your mentor the best options for your project. Each organization will have their own preference on how they want you to show your work product. These next couple of weeks are a very important time to be sure you are communicating regularly with your mentors.

And the final evaluation is not just an evaluation of your mentor, you must include a URL to the work you have produced in GSoC - be sure to read the Work Product Submission Guidelines thoroughly for all of the details.

GSoC 2021: Payoneer Updates and editing your School name

We hope this first week of community bonding with your organizations is going well. We have some additional tips to help you with your GSoC summer, please keep reading for more details.

#### Payoneer Updates

There have been quite a few folks asking some of the same questions so we wanted to address them here for you.

For students with no last name or 1 initial as their last name - payees should apply in most cases with their name exactly as it appears on their government-issued ID. For those legitimately without a last name, they should apply with their first/given name twice, as the last name field is mandatory.

**Acceptable ID's** - Payoneer can only accept a copy of an actual government-issued ID \*card\* for their verification purposes. If you have another form of government issued ID already, you may try to submit this. Payoneer also understands the ongoing crisis has made the issuing of new cards a challenge in many regions, so if you have a special circumstance and do not have any form of a government issued ID, please reach out to Payoneer right away.

#### Payment options for students in Russia, India and Venezuela -

In Russia and India, prepaid cards are NOT an option but bank transfers are available.

In Venezuela, only prepaid cards are supported. Bank transfers are NOT supported to Venezuelan banks.

Over 930 of you have already successfully created your Payoneer accounts - thanks! For the rest of you you still have until June 1 to create your account but please don't wait until the last minute.

If you have a special situation where you can't get a specific required doc for Payoneer until sometime in June and will not be able to make the June 1 deadline please email us and we will make a note of it - be aware it is possible your stipend payments will be delayed if you don't have your account registered by June 1.

# GSoC 2021: Welcome and Important Notes for your GSoC Summer!

Welcome to Google Summer of Code 2021! We look forward to seeing the great things you will accomplish this summer during the program - welcome to the GSoC community!

Please read this entire email. It contains very important information regarding your participation in GSoC 2021. Throughout the program, you will receive more important emails from Google, please be sure to read them all very carefully. To avoid emails from us being marked as spam please add summerofcode-noreply@google.com as a trusted contact. You are responsible for meeting all required deadlines and these emails will remind you of deadlines as well as give you important details throughout the program to help you have a successful GSoC.

#### What do I do now?

- 1. Read the Accepted Students Information page VERY IMPORTANT!
- 2. Be sure to read the <u>GSoC roles and responsibilities</u> page so you know what is expected of you but also what to expect from your Mentor this summer.
- 3. Talk to your mentor and community!
- 4. Set up your Payoneer account using the special link sent in the personalized email sent in the last couple of hours. Read that email carefully and follow the instructions to be sure you can receive the stipend payments by the required deadline (June 1).
- 5. In case you haven't seen the short YouTube video we created "Congrats! You're a GSoC student" check it out for some helpful tips for the summer (it's less than 3 minutes).

# Withdrawing from GSoC 2021

If you need to withdraw from GSoC 2021 now or at any point during the program, please be sure to contact your mentor immediately so they know that you are withdrawing. Then withdraw yourself from the GSoC program by hitting the "withdraw" button on your dashboard. Once this button is pushed you can not get back into the GSoC 2021 program.

# Receiving your GSoC Stipends

Be sure to read the instructions on how to register for your Payoneer account in the email we sent you from <a href="mailto:google.com">gsoc-support@google.com</a> a couple of hours ago. You **MUST** use the specific link that we sent you in the previous email to set up your Payoneer account as it is unique to you. Remember to also read the <a href="mailto:gSoC Payoneer page">GSoC Payoneer page</a>.

#### Payoneer

- Remember to also read the <u>GSoC Payoneer page</u>.
- Please just go ahead and register for your Payoneer account in the next week or so (must do it by EOD June 1), once it is done you can focus 100% on your community bonding period. It should take you less than 25 minutes to submit the registration.
- Many non-US based students ask us if it is better to receive funds in your local currency
  or in USD. Our experience is that your local currency is preferable because Payoneer's
  exchange fees are often better than what your local bank may charge. Google covers a
  majority of the other fees around your cards or bank transfers, but does not cover
  currency exchange fees. Every bank is different, which makes it difficult for Google or
  Payoneer to provide a specific estimate of which method is better.
- After you submit your Payoneer registration it will usually take 1-4 business days to
  receive an approval email from Payoneer saying "Congratulations your Payoneer
  account application has been approved!" You just need to register for your account by
  June 1st, don't worry if it takes another week to receive the success confirmation email
  from Payoneer, that is fine.

<u>For US STUDENTS ONLY</u>: If you are subject to US taxes, you will need to complete <u>this</u> request form in the next week (before May 25) so that Payoneer can send you the request to complete your tax forms on your Payoneer dashboard.

# Not Planning to Accept any Stipends?

We realize for some students the stipend is something they can not accept due to their visa status, etc. That is okay, but please do the following two things so we know you do not wish to accept any funds - <u>before June 1st.</u>

- 1) Simply don't register for a Payoneer account (no account=no stipend)
- Complete this <u>form rejecting the stipend</u> <u>before June 1st</u> so we will stop reminding you to register for a Payoneer account.
