Autism Awareness activities will take place this month, stay tuned for dates to follow!

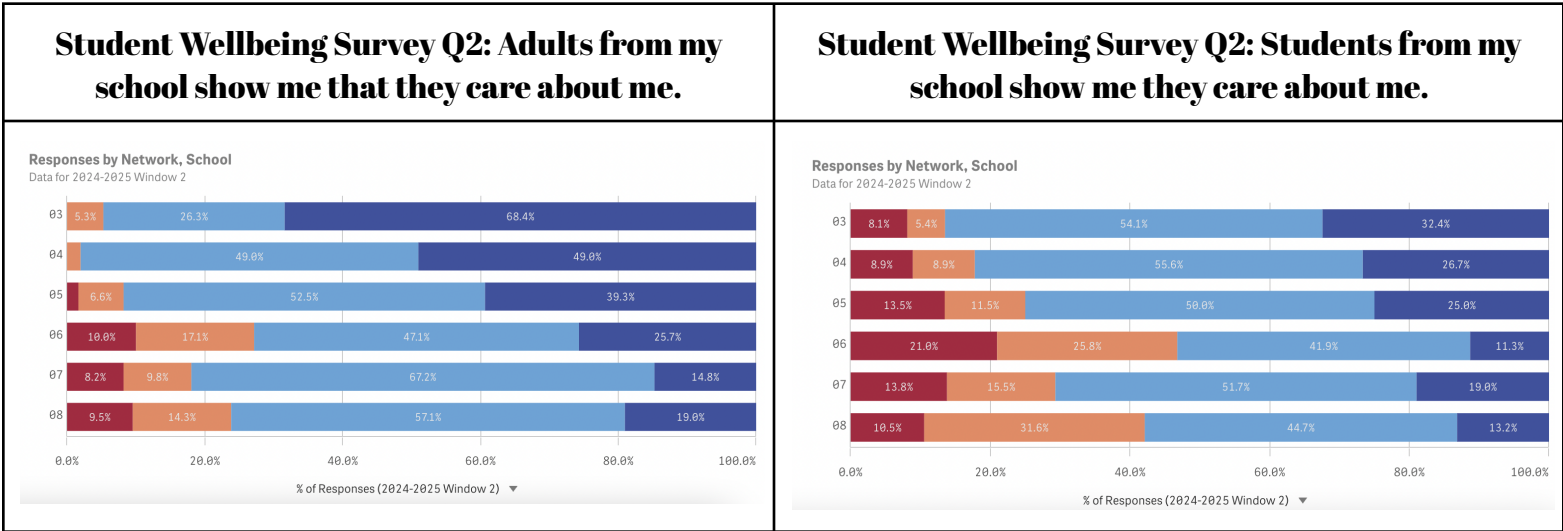
