


8er's Commission TOS

- Vent art






Prices:

You don't have to pay me until I finish the commission, at which point you must before I send you the finished product.

> Basic (Hand Drawn)

- Bust/Head - \$10
- Half Body - \$20
- Full Body - \$30
 - + 50% per additional character(s)
 - + \$5 for background
- **Fully Rendered** (color blending, lighting, fx) - **\$45**
 - + 50% per additional character(s)
 - + \$5 for background

> Battle Sprite

- Regular - \$15
- Animated - \$40
- Shaded - \$20
- **Animated + Shaded - \$50**

> Dialogue Sprites

- \$10/sprite
- \$15/sprite (shaded)

> Overworld Sprites

- \$5/sprite (shading doesn't affect prices)

Once I have sent you the finished product, you may request changes be made and (given they're in reason), I'll do them, free of charge.

Commission Process (Drawing):

1 Contact:

- You must commission me through Discord DMs.
- You must have a visual ref and/or written description of whatever character you want me to draw. I am not here to design your character for you.
- You may also provide a pose you want them drawn in, though this is optional.
- Expect a response within the next 24-48 hours.

2 Sketching:

- Once the initial contact is made, I will begin sketching.
- Once I am done, I will send you the first draft for feedback.
- Once adjustments have been made (if need be), I will move on to lineart.
- All-in-all, Sketching usually only takes me a day at most.

3 Lineart + Flat Color:

- Once the sketch is done, I will begin the lineart.
- Once again, when I'm done, I will send it in for feedback.
- After any necessary adjustments, I will quickly add the flat color.
- Lineart and Color usually takes half a day or more.

4 Shading and/or Rendering:

- Once lineart and color is done, I will add cel-shading.
- Usually, cel-shading only takes a couple hours.
- Or, if requested, I will begin doing full rendering + background.
- This usually takes me about another day.
- Once I am done, you must pay me the full amount before I will send it to you. If you don't, you ain't gettin the commission.

Commission Process (Pixel Art):

1 Contact:

- You must commission me through Discord DMs.
- You must have a visual and/or written description of the character you want me to sprite.
- You may also provide a pose you want them drawn in, though this is optional.
- Expect a response within the next 24-48 hours.

2 Initial Sprite:

- Once the initial contact is made, I will begin making the sprite.
- Once I am done, I will send you the first draft for feedback.
- Once adjustments have been made (if need be), I will move on to any other sprites, or animating it, if need be..
- All-in-all, for Overworld sprites, they don't take very long for me, and Battle Sprites only take a day at most.

Consumer Use:

> The commissioner reserves the right to:

- Owning their characters, obviously.
I don't suddenly own your character(s) just because I drew them lol.
- Share the finished commission(s) in their social media, but with proper credit.
- Using said finished commission as a profile picture, or banner.
- Printing for personal use.

> The commissioner does NOT have the right to:

- Claim the art as their own.
- Remove my signature/watermark.
- Change my art without my consent.

Delay may arise due to life and other personal matters.

You will be notified if there is a delay.
