Talent Guidelines

- Performances should be no longer than 5 minutes.
- A “talent” includes singing, dancing, musical instruments, monologue, clowning, etc.
- If a keyboard is needed for your act, you need to let Extension Staff know on registration form.
- **It is important to submit your music with your registration form. Music can be submitted as a digital file on a flash drive or a link. NOTE - Oak-land Middle School blocks YouTube videos.**
- Open to all 4-H and Cloverbud members.
- One form should be submitted per group or individual talent act.

Talent Awards

- Each 4-Her will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon. Cloverbuds will receive a participation ribbon.
- Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected in the Junior and Senior Division.
- Participants in 6th grade and older and earning a blue ribbon will be eligible for the State Fair Line-up.
- Winners will be offered the opportunity of performing the same act at the Washington County fair on the Sunday of the fair at 2 pm.
