TLDR:

-In a village with a Tradition of letting second born children grow up training in a Swordsman school, a Riolu was born.

-Has three notable friends that he grew up with, learning, playing, and doing everything together. They are all so close they are more like siblings than friends. They are a Zorua(Kanbei) And twin Sneasels (Inei and Hika, Shiny Hisuian and Johtonian respectively)

-Master has the four take on three tests to determine who is worthy of carrying his magical blade, and his job when he retires.

-Takeru does not do the best, but was more empathetic/helpful/supportive to his fellows, and was given the blade as part of the test was about empathy as

well

-Zorua becomes angered and steals the blade. Takeru is sent after him. -Saves a freshly kidnapped Kohana from Pirates, who had brashly kidnapped her right off of Ethovalon's port! Likely braver and more foolish due to remnant effects of the shadow affliction.

It is Tradition in the town of Callinbern, for parents to send their second born children to be trained in the ways of the sword. This tradition came to be not for malicious means, but rather as a way to give the second born a good start in their lives. It is never enforced, but merely an option.

This is what happened with Takeru. He was the second born son in his family, and was therefore sent to the swordsman's school to be raised alongside the other apprentices that would be in his generation. And this generation would be a special one.

The Riolu was brought up alongside a Zorua named Kanbei, who was like a brother to him, and twin Sneasel: The Johtonian Hika, And the shiny Hisuian Inei. There were more apprentices, but they were either younger or older.
Together, these four would do everything together. Most importantly, learning the ways of the sword. Swordfighting, sword creation, anything to do with mastery of the sword.

When they were all 18, The Master of the school called these 4 alone, and announced that for one of them, they would be given a special gift: His Sword. He was getting up in years, and would be retiring soon. The one who would receive his sword would take over the school, as well as the job of being Callinbern's protector. The Final test, was of course, a test of their combat prowess. In this test, Takeru was really capable of showing what he was made of! Kicking the tails of the Sneasel twins easily! But they were good natured about it, and it was a fair fight overall! When he fought his Zorua brother, however.... He would lose. But it was a long and hard fought battle! Kanbei helped him up with a grin. "No matter what, we will defend this place together." He would speak with confidence. And Takeru agreed. All four of them would! The Master at last called the four back again. It was time to announce who would be inheriting his blade.

Takeru would inherit the blade. He was shocked. As was Kanbei. But the Sneasel twins just grinned and cheered their friend on! As far as they were concerned, it was deserved! They seemed strangely crazed.... Their auras were off. Thankfully, all of them were soon knocked out. Going through the enemy ship, he found a shiny Vulpix woman all tied up! She had apparently been recently kidnapped from Ethovalon! Her name was Kohana, and she was part of the GCSF.

Not too long after, another ship came zooming into view, led by this Sawsbuck woman who was shouting at the pirate ship. It kinda scared Takeru, actually. But Kohana was quick to diffuse the situation, explaining that Takeru and his random crew had actually saved her! Being impressed, the Sawsbuck, Liah, would invite Takeru to join her Bounty Hunter Team Thistles & Thorns.

The young man would accept the invite. He had just about ran out of money, and no sign of Kanbei meant he had very little else to do..... Takeru Would settle into his new life here, relieved that at least for now, any horrible confrontation with his brother could wait. So Liah and her team took him back with them to Ethovalon, where they would also imprison the Pirates.

TLDR update:

-Was summoned back to Callinbern after his inaction of finding Kanbei resulted in said Zorua twisting due to magic corruption
-Had to duel Kanbei to death. He tried to not kill Kanbei, but Kanbei blinded him in his one eye, and he had to kill him in self defence after that
-His master dismissed him forever. Effectively exiled.
-Hika and Inei brought him to a healing spring that was also an evolution spring, where he evolved!
-He is now moving forward

Takeru is blind in his bandaged eye. If he focuses, he can see vague aura outlines through it, but it takes a lot out of him to do so.
