

# **MyOn: My Online Library**

**Your child has access to an online library with 1,000s of books to choose from!  
Please use the following directions to have your child practice reading at home.**

**If you are using a laptop/chromebook:**

**To log in:**

1. Go to [scasd.org](http://scasd.org)
  2. Click on resources
  3. Click on Student Links
  4. Click on SCASD Clever login link
  5. Click on Log in with Google
  6. Once your child is logged in, click on Myon.
- If this is your child's first time using their google account on the device, they will have to enter their email address and password or click clever badge log in.
  - If you have more than one google account on the device, each child will have to log out and select the account you want to use.

**To log out:**

1. Click on the red x to exit myon. (If you are in the middle of a book, you will have to click on the house button to get back to the main screen to find the red x)
2. Close the myon window by clicking on the x
3. Log out of clever by clicking on your name and clicking log out

**If you have multiple students in your family:**

When you log in to google, you have to switch from one child to the other's google account. When you go to google, in the upper right hand corner of the screen the initial of the last child logged in will appear. Click on it and click on sign out. Then you can have the next child log in and follow the steps that are given above.

### **When students log on for the first time:**

They will have to take a screener. This helps the program find your child's independent reading level so they can recommend books for them. It is crucial that your child do this on their own, without any support from you. If you help them, the books that are recommended to them may be too hard for them. Also, if your child does not try their best, the recommended books may be too easy. As the students use this, it will give them benchmark checkins to see if they need to adjust their level and the book recommendations. Following the screener, they will be asked to fill out an interest inventory so they can share their reading interests. This helps the program recommend books to them at their level that they will be interested in reading.

### **To read the books:**

- Click on library
  - Click on recommended to see books that are recommended based on your child's screener results and interests (this is the best way to search for good fit books)
  - Click on browse to search for books by topic
  - Click on my list to see all the books your child has added to their list of books they want to read

### **When reading a book:**

- Students must click "end" to the right side of the last page of a book in order for the book to count as read.
- After the students read a book and click end, they will be asked to review the book. They must select their rating by clicking 1-5 stars and can type in a review. Then they click save review and it will take them to the quiz.

### **To do assignments:**

- If a teacher has assigned a project to your child, it will show up when they log in as a new project. This could be a book to read, a list of books to choose from, or a book with a graphic organizer, an open ended question to respond to, or suggestions of things to do with the online tools (post-its, highlighters, journals, etc)

**To log in with a tablet:**

There is an app you can use or you can also connect to the internet browser and use the above directions. If using the app, you may not be able to add books, but you can access the books that are already on your list.

It is suggested that you use the internet (chrome if possible) to use it like you would on a chromebook to get the full benefits of the program.
