Prior credit evaluation for transfer, second degree seeking students or non-degree seeking students policy

Nutrition and Foods, Dietetic 840B

Students must apply and be accepted to Appalachian State University
The Office of Transfer Services will evaluate prior course credits.
Students will be required to meet Dietetics Program of Study (POS) requirements
DPD Program faculty will evaluate any Nutrition DPD required coursework for potential credit.

Course catalog description and syllabus may be required.

In order to receive a Verification Statement at the DPD level from Appalachian State University, interested parties must follow university policies regarding transferring in prior credit Coursework for DPD requirements outside of the Nutrition and Foods department must be less than 10 years old. (Examples: Intro to Psychology, Intro to Statistics, Chemistry I and II, Survey of Accounting) Coursework for DPD Nutrition equivalent courses must be less than 5 years old and will require a syllabus to be provided for evaluation.

Other requirements for receiving a Verification Statement from Appalachian State University DPD program beginning with 2020-21 Programs of Study:

- Demonstrate minimum of 2.8 GPA in previous coursework for admission, maintain a 2.8 GPA or >
- Minimum of a "C" in all DPD required coursework, no > than 2 repeats in any DPD required course
