1. Bedford High School Senior class of 2026
2. College bound senior, pursuing a STEM course of study;
3. Cumulative Grade Point Average for seven (7) consecutive semesters of high school class work should place student in the top 20% of his/her class;
4. Have demonstrated high achievement in scholastic and extracurricular activities;
5. Have a record of performance in activities both in school and in the community;
6. Have a sound interest in positively impacting others;
7. Have completed and executed the Waiver set forth on Page 1 of the attached scholarship application;
8. Complete the attached Scholarship Application;
9. Have a principal, counselor, teacher or other extracurricular adult advisor complete a letter of recommendation for you for this scholarship;
10. Have a transcript of your high school grades attached to the scholarship application (Bedford High School Counseling office will attach your transcript)
11. **Submit this scholarship application, with all blanks appropriately completed, to the Bedford High School Counseling Department by April 15, 2026 no later than 2:45.**
12. **No emailed or faxed copies of the completed application will be accepted. You must return the paper application.**

The Scholarship Selection Committee will rank applications based on overall academic achievement. Final selection will be based on the applicant's essay.

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ESSAY

The Alyssa and Justin Haun Memorial Scholarship was established through The Precious & Free Foundation as a means to give back to the community that gave so much to the Haun family during the aftermath of their tragic deaths. Alyssa Marie Haun and her brother Justin Trevor Haun passed away suddenly and unexpectedly on July 4, 2018. Alyssa was entering her Junior Year at Highland High School with aspirations to obtain advanced degrees in Chemical Engineering. Justin had completed his 8th Grade Year at Bedford Junior High School, in Temperance, MI and was planning to enter his Freshman Year at the Monroe County Middle College in Monroe with a focus on Life Sciences. He planned to become a neurosurgeon. Alyssa was driven to succeed in her academic endeavors. She was a member of the National Honor Society, the Camerata Orchestra (violin), the Speech and Debate Team, the Cross-Country Team, the Robotics Team, the Girl Scouts, and the Toledo ZooTeen Program. Justin was very kind hearted. He was a member of the Cross-Country Team, the Orchestra (bass), the Robotics Team, and the Quiz Bowl Team (obtaining the County Championship Title). Both students had high expectations of changing the world in uniquely different ways. With their deaths, their parents have made it their mission to make sure that through Alyssa and Justin, lives can still be changed.
