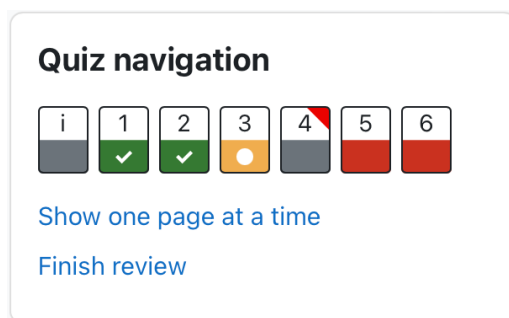

- A wrong answer is shown with the bottom half red
- An essay question (requiring manual marking) is shown with the bottom half grey
- A flagged question is shown with a red triangle at the top right



In the questions themselves, correct answers will be in green with a check mark next to it. Incorrect answers will be in red with a cross next to it.

You may also receive general feedback or specific feedback on each question and/or overall feedback on your final score.

Although the quiz may have been split into multiple pages, the review will show all the questions on a single page to make it easier to navigate. You can choose to review the quiz in separate pages as it was when you took the quiz.
