Never, Never, Never Give In!

During World War II, Prime Minister Winston Churchill lifted the spirits of his countrymen by saying these famous words: "Never, never, never give in." Read Galatians 6:9.

1. Never Give In when you fail.

Failure is no different from success, if you don't give in. John Maxwell wrote, "To achieve your dreams, you must embrace adversity and make failure a regular part of your life." Thomas Edison failed over eight thousand times before he invented the light bulb. Describe a time when you failed to achieve a goal. How did you handle failure? 2 Corinthians 4:1; 2 Corinthians 4:16

2. Never Give In when others don't believe in you, and reject you.

The apostle Paul endured ridicule, beatings, and prison but continued to share the gospel. How can having the same attitude as Paul help you when you fail? Give some examples of times when you thought you failed, but God used it for the good. How can failure benefit your growth in Christ?
