Synopsis

Long ago, the Earth thrived in harmony, united by the three primal elements: Air, Earth, and Water. But darkness loomed, as threats from the far reaches of space—and sinister forces of Earth itself—conspired to spread malice and evil across the land. To defend the planet, Zordon joined forces with Earth's ancient guardian and protector, Elandor. Characters

Rangers

Jesse Delgado/Red Guardian Ranger (Air) (Mexican - American) - Fearless and warm-hearted with a goofy, airheaded charm. Loves cracking jokes and lifting spirits, even if it sometimes gets him into trouble. His heart is in the right place, though he often rushes headfirst without thinking things through.

Hannah Yoon/Pink Guardian Ranger (Air) (Korean - American) - Softspoken, creative artist, introverted but caring. Often lost in her sketchbook, she expresses what she can't say out loud through her art. Has a distant but loving relationship with her single father who works long hours.

Malik Carter/Black Guardian Ranger (Earth) (African - American) - Loud, confident, and always trying to act “the oldest” or “the responsible one” — even when he's not. Uses humor and bravado to mask insecurities about living up to the legacy and being a good role model for his younger sister and friends.

Kiara Carter/Yellow Guardian Ranger (Earth) (African - American) - Spunky, punky, and fiercely independent. Witty and sharp-tongued, she refuses to be boxed in by the idea of “legacy” or what others expect. Protective of Malik but often teases him to keep him grounded.

Rowan Pierce/Blue Guardian Ranger (Water) (Caucasian - American) - Calm, intelligent, and serious — the oldest of the group. He's a natural problem solver but struggles to open up emotionally, leading others to see him as distant or cold.

Robo Knight - An ancient protector that can transform into a Zord itself. Created by Elandor to defend Earth during past conflicts. Originally uncompromising and extreme in his methods—viewed life in black and white. Stoic, single-minded, and rigid at first. Views humans as unpredictable and sometimes reckless but slowly learns compassion and the complexity of life.

Allies

Mentors and Helpers

Elandor - An ancient guardian of Earth and the trusted protégé of Zordon, Elandor stands as a timeless source of wisdom and strength. A guiding force for the young Rangers, he not only sends them on crucial missions but also offers mentorship and emotional support—serving as a steadfast father figure in times of crisis. His knowledge is vast, his purpose unwavering, and his bond with the Rangers unbreakable.

D.A.T.A.S/Data - The successor to the Alpha series and Elandor's assistant. An innocent, naive but secretly intelligent robot helper shaped like an Arcade machine who has a childlike wonder to anything which Elandor built him to be like so the Rangers can instantly relate to him. In times of peril, he can transform into his Megazord mode called the "Giga D.A.T.A.S. Battlezord"

Daily Life

Ms. Melissa Diaz – The dedicated homeroom teacher of the Rangers, known for her studious nature and unwavering commitment to helping her students reach their full potential. As an assistant to Elandor, she gradually uncovers the hidden truths behind the team. Yet, out of deep compassion and loyalty, she chooses to keep their secrets safe, guided by the kindness in her heart.

Principal Renee Trusk - Stern, no nonsense, and very observant, Principal Trusk runs the school with a firm hand and sharp eye. Always suspicious when the Rangers run off for "emergencies," She keeps a mental record of said absences and strange behavior. Though seen as extremely strict and cold. She actually does care for the school and students well being.

Brock Denton & Simon Cruz – A pair of wannabe influencers at the Rangers' school, obsessed with exposing the Rangers' "big secret." Brock is loud, obnoxious, and convinced he's destined for fame, while Simon is the snarky, scheming sidekick always looking to make a quick buck off their antics. Their plans inevitably backfire, leaving them looking like fools—or in need of rescue by the very Rangers they're trying to unmask, never realizing the heroes are right under their noses.

Dr. Daniel Yoon - Hannah's single father, a respected and skilled surgeon who works very long, grueling hours at the hospital. He's loving but distant, often too exhausted or preoccupied to notice how lonely his daughter feels. He pushes Hannah to succeed academically, not always realizing how much she craves emotional connection instead of pressure. Despite his absence, he's deeply proud of her and worries he's failing as a parent, but the struggle was to express it.

Villains

Vrak (a new take on Megaforce Vrak and Brajira of the Messiah/Bladerun of Goseiger) - The main villain of this series. As the second prince of the Armada, he is cold, calculating, sadistic and self-absorbed, Vrak was sent to Earth to prepare it for conquest — but the truth is far darker. Born with the lingering DNA/essence of Dark Specter, the Grand Monarch of Evil, Vrak believes himself to be the next step in evolution — a god destined to reshape the universe. While his father sees Earth as just another colony, Vrak sees it as the cradle of his ascension. Behind his calm intelligence lies a messianic hunger to betray the Armada, annihilate his lineage, and make the universe in his own image.

Warstar - A sub division of the Armada sent to prepare earth for conquest. led by Admiral Mal'drak and his Insectoid generals, they carry out mission and wars with precision and pride seeking to claim the planet as the first step of the Armada's conquest over the cosmos

(Note: The Armada is still my take on Zangyack from Gokaiger and Armada from Super Megaforce but that will wait)

Admiral Mal'drak (Great King Mons Drake of the Planet and Admiral Malkor) - The leader of the Warstar and a high ranking general of the Armada empire. Originally an independent conqueror taken in by Emperor Marvo, Mal'drak has his overzealous loyalty to the royal family and cause of the Armada to rule. At Emperor Marvo's behest, Mal'drak took the young Prince Vrak under his wing — both to train him in the art of planetary warfare and to test his worth as heir to the Armada's legacy.

Krytros (Dereputa of the Meteor and Creepox) - The high ranking general of the Warstar and Mal'Drak's second in command. Priding himself in honor and instincts, Krytros has lived for the thrill of combat, seeing every war battle as a test for his power. Having once clashed with the previous Red Guardian Ranger, he now sees Jesse as his destined rival and wishes to settle the score.

Dreadbeast Legion - Toxic monsters born from pollution and negative emotions that fought the past Guardian Force Rangers and Robo Knight that were sealed to never be released. Are now found and released now ready to make the entire world theirs and put the Dreadbeast on top of the food chain.

Ozymurk (Makunin of the Blob and Bigs) - One of the two leaders of the Dreadbeast Legion. A prideful and eloquent tyrant, Ozymurk believes the Dreadbeasts are the rightful rulers of Earth—destined to subjugate humanity under their might. Beneath his refined speech and regal posture, he harbors a twisted joy in conquest and chaos. Despite his arrogance, he shares a genuine camaraderie with his longtime partner-in-crime, Gravok, often trading playful banter even amid battle.

Gravok (Kinggon of the Bigfoot and Bluefur) - Co-leader of the Dreadbeast Legion alongside Ozymurk. A violent, manic, and hot-headed powerhouse, Gravok's brute strength hides a surprisingly sharp mind and talent for battlefield strategy. He may act like a simple brawler, but his cunning and unpredictability make him just as dangerous as his partner. Fiercely loyal to Ozymurk, he fully believes the Dreadbeasts are destined to reclaim Earth as their dominion.

Neo-Machine Empire - A mechanical empire born from the remains of the old Machine Empire of Power Rangers: Zeo, they are still on the goal of cyberizing all life in the universe, erasing

emotion and free will in the name of machine evolution. Their new campaign begins on Earth—where humanity’s resistance will determine the fate of all living beings.

Mechagog (Robgog of the 10-Sai and The Messenger) - Once an alien that was kidnapped a long time ago by the original Machine Empire from Zeo, he was forcefully cyberized and rebuilt to become an android but surprisingly, enjoys this new body. Callous, megalomaniacal, vindictive, cruel and sadistic, Mechagog plans to revive the glory of the Machine Empire by converting all organic life into machines, believing only the mechanical are worthy to rule the galaxy.

Metal Alice – The cold, calculating right hand of Mechagog, personally built to embody perfection and obedience. She serves him with unwavering loyalty, believing the Machine Empire’s rule to be the ultimate form of order. Yet, as the war drags on, small traces of humanity begin to surface within her — curiosity, compassion, and even affection toward Vrak. But such emotions were never part of her design... and in the end, they may become her undoing.

Morphers, Weapons and Zords



Guardian Morphers (Tensouders and Gosei Morphers): The main Morpher of the 5 main Guardian Force Rangers. Each Morphers uses “Guardian Cards” to channel each of the 3 elemental powers, transform into their Ranger form, summon weapons or Zords and activate special attacks. To use a card, a Ranger inserts into the device and calls out the Guardian command phrase, which unlocks the ability encoded in the card and triggers their transformation or an ability.



Sentinel Morpher (Leon Cellular) - The unique, tactical Morpher used by Robo Knight. Unlike the Rangers' simple card-based devices, this Morpher also utilizes a specialized keypad interface that allows Robo Knight to input 3-digit codes to trigger his abilities. While it possesses a scanner in the lion's head for high-level "Knight Dynamic" cards, its primary function is to process raw elemental data. To activate a command, Robo Knight inserts a card in the scanner, inputs a specific numeric sequence, reflecting his precise and logical nature, which allows him to transform between his Ranger and Zord forms, manifest weapons, and execute calculated elemental strikes.
