I am writing to express my concern regarding bill SB 866 introduced by Senator Weiner and Senator Pan. SB866 does not address some important factors in healthcare, such as a child will not know his or her own medical history. With treatments like vaccines, now available at different service providers who are not Primary care physicians, I am also concerned about physicians and providers administering vaccines, or any treatments for that matter without having seen a patient's prior medical history.

I urge you to vote no on SB866 and consider these concerns as they can truly be life altering.

The purpose of my letter is to ask Senator _____ to oppose this bill which would authorize a minor 12 years of age or older to consent to vaccines that meet specified federal agency criteria without parental consent.
