Principal's Pen

Please be careful if you elect to continue using the Grayfox gate as we still have trip hazards and unsafe driving there. Please consider using the safer Fernhill gate even if it takes a bit longer. Fernhill is our preferred gate. Linked here is our original Malibu Elementary Safe Student Drop Off and Pick Up Plan. (This plan was drafted with the City and our SSC when our school was founded some three years ago.) Again, I am asking you to re-familiarize yourselves with the plan. Note that we are no longer encouraging anyone to use the Grayfox Gate, but rather the safer Fernhill Gate. Text in red makes this point more clear. In March I will meet with the Teacher Leadership Team to consider reassigning teachers currently on Dismissal Gate Duty to AM recess duty. As you know we are shorthanded and we must use our staff resources judiciously. To be determined. As always, let me know if you have questions, concerns, or suggestions,

Last week during our school Covid Surveillance testing two new positives were discovered. Both were in kindergarten. The class was placed on a Modified Quarantine that requires masking for 10 days, both inside and outside. To help everyone keep organized please use our **Calendar of Current Classroom Modified Quarantines for your ease of reference:** Link Students who are on quarantine while on campus will need to continue wearing masks <u>outside</u> during the course of their quarantine. We will monitor this as much as possible, however, recognize that adhering to this requirement will be the responsibility of the students and parents, as well as the staff. Each week we hope we receive no sad news about positive Covid cases, however when we do, that person is put on Home Isolation and classmates are placed on Modified Quarantine. With this in mind, our situation remains fluid.

On Friday, our students will bring home their report cards. Attendance marks are dated to February 11th. Please look for positives and goal areas to discuss with your child. Praise effort and support excellent attendance in the coming weeks. The remainder of February and March are key weeks for learning before we shift to spring break and then the final push for the school year. Now is a good time to reinforce on-task expectations with your child and by recommitting to routines that support excellent attendance. I want to thank our teachers for all the work they have put into documenting achievement, and helping students and parents stay focused on goal areas.

Leveled Reading: Ensure you know your child's evolving reading level range. Ask the teacher periodically for your child's level range. Make sure your child reads within their level range for 30 minutes a day, seven days a week. Encourage your child to re-read and read aloud. This leads to prosody. (Prosody means reading with expression — with the appropriate rhythm, tone, pitch, pauses, and stresses for the text. Prosody depends on both accuracy and rate. In order to read with expression, the student must be able to read words efficiently and break the text into meaningful syntactic and semantic units.) Prosody leads to comprehension.
