6. Time for Time Handbook Change Motion [HHS Administration]

- Authorship Speech / Introduction
 - Zane Schiffman [A-Mod] gave a brief overview
 - Last year, this practice was implemented and worked well
 - Ms. Beaupre gave an explanation of how the motion works
 - If a student is unexcused tardy to class 5 times, they serve an equal amount of time in a designated area during activity period, or have detention before school, during lunch, or after school to "payback" the time they were late to class
 - Allows for more flexibility
 - Student only serves the amount of time that they missed
- Question Session
 - What does "time-for-time" mean? The wording is not in the motion.

- A student who is late for class serves back the lost class time by having to go to a designated space
 - Usually the Front Office
 - Student remains there for the amount of time they were tardy
- Who is keeping track of the time of how late a student is to class [in order for the time to be “paid back”]
 - Has not been specifically addressed
- When [speaker] marks a student tardy, [speaker] does not specifically mark by how many minutes a student is late. What would happen if a student is late by only a few minutes?
 - Most likely, the student will serve the full 15 minutes even if they are late by less than 15 minutes.
- If a student is late by one or two minutes over 5 times, do they serve the full 15 minutes?
 - The student has a conversation with an Associate Principal
 - Then, the student “serves” time in the office
 - They lose their free time
 - If their free time is during lunch, they can get their lunch from the Caf, but they will eat in a designated area
 - The teacher in whose class the student was late to can request for a student to spend time with them
- This system sounds like a time-out. Is it?
 - Sort of, but not really
 - In a time-out, you talk about what you are going to do next time that will be a better choice
 - In this case, the student will have already had that conversation with Administration before serving time-for-time
- Question Session Closes
