

The A+C Book Award 2025/6

For a book which makes an outstanding contribution to the dialogue between religious faith and the visual arts.

Background

This is the only literary prize worldwide for a publication that notably advances a public understanding of the relationship between the visual arts and religious experience, beliefs and practice.

The prize of £1000 will go to the author of the winning book.

Julian Bell is a painter whose work includes a sequence of panels based on the Book of Genesis, and a writer about contemporary and historical art in books such as *What is Painting?* (2017).

Dr Aaron Rosen is Executive Director of The Clemente Course in the Humanities, Visiting Professor at King's College London, and Founder of The Parsonage Gallery.
