1. CEP- Review Setting Progress Monitoring Targets:

- Students were given the ROAR diagnostic in grades 3-5. This assessment tests them on foundational literacy skills and is aligned with elementary level programs related to intervention. The results of this assessment help us match the appropriate intervention program to each child. Students in grades 3-5 that tested out of the Phonics for Reading program, were not ready for Close Reading enrichment, so many of these students may be matched with the REWARDS program which is a program by Anita Archer that is the next step after Phonics for Reading. Tier 1 instruction occurs in the classroom. Tier 2 takes place during the MTSS period. From 7:20-7:40 we would like to have tier 3 support. These students have already been identified and parents will be notified.

2. Title 1/ PAC: Parents:

Survey Results: Parents prefer to be contacted via text message and email. 47% feel confident in understanding their child's academic progress. Parents have requested workshops on literacy, math, and digital programs. Parents prefer to have meetings in the morning and prefer that they be virtual. Parents will vote this afternoon on how the Title 1 money will be spent.

3. **Toy Drive:** We were able to get 1 gift for each student in the school, which will be distributed on December 23rd. The Holiday show will take place on Friday December 19th.
4. PS 58 is donating another 30 bags of food for families in temporary housing. The school secretary and family worker will pick up the bags and distribute to families.
