

Hellam Township Police Department Celebrates Success of First Annual Car, Truck & Motorcycle Show

The 1st annual HTPD car, truck & motorcycle show was a success.

The show was held on Saturday, October 4th, 2025, from 10 am to 2 pm, at the Hellam Township Municipal Building. Pre-registration was available for a \$15 fee, or participants could opt to register the day of the show from 8-11 am for a \$20 fee. All proceeds benefitted the HTPD Motorcycle Unit Fund.
