How to approach 'Describe'	How to approach 'Identify and describe'
Whilst it's not awarded like this, you need to write enough to gain 3 marks. This question is a describe so you don't need to identify first. You need to say what you see.	Identify (one mark) then describe (2 marks). Make your identification clear and accurate for the question. Then describe the way you refer to. Keep it linked to the identified way.

Top tips:

- Read the question carefully as subtle differences can mean different things (e.g. home based vs school based, quantitative vs qualitative).
- Use your glossaries many 3 mark questions are 'define what sociologists mean by....'
- Include key terms where appropriate
- Only address what is asked don't go off on a tangent!
