
2025 ACHS Marching Titans Handbook

Important: Forms and Fees for 2025 Marching Titans

To ensure your participation in the Alexandria City High School Marching Titans for the 2025 season, please note the following required forms and fees:

Required Forms:

- Online Registration Form: Due Wednesday, May 28
- Field Trip Authorization Form: Due Thursday, May 28
- Emergency Care Form: Due Thursday, May 28

Marching Band Fee:

- A participation fee of \$170 is required for all members of the ACHS Marching
 Titans. These funds are essential for covering the costs of equipment, additional
 instruction, music, copyright agreements, competitions, and other vital resources.
- Payments can be made by check (ACHS, cash, or myschoolbucks.com)

New Member Shoe Purchase (Excluding Color Guard):

• All new marching band members (excluding color guard) must purchase "Dinkles" marching band shoes at a cost of \$30. These shoes ensure a uniform appearance and are durable for your entire time in the band program.

Deadline for Forms and Fees:

All forms and fees are due by Thursday, May 28

Important Reminder:

• Failure to submit all required forms and fees by the deadline may result in the student losing their position on the field or being placed in a different band class.

Financial Assistance:

• If you anticipate any financial difficulties in meeting the fee deadline, please contact Mr. Rogers as soon as possible to discuss potential arrangements.

Marching Band Membership & Policies

Who Participates?

- Required: All 9th-12th grade students enrolled in Symphonic Band (including Percussion Ensemble) and Wind Ensemble (Advanced Percussion) are members of the marching band as part of their band class.
- Encouraged: Concert Band and 8th-grade students are strongly encouraged to participate.
- **Exemption:** Only students with a signed ACHS fall sports waiver submitted to Mr. Rogers are excused.

Attendance & Grading

- Marching band is a graded component of your band class.
- Attendance and participation are significant factors in your individual band grade.
- Be technically and mentally prepared for all performances.
- Unexcused absence from a performance will result in a significant penalty.
- Your absence impacts the entire ensemble's performance.
- The rehearsal and performance schedule is published in advance; address conflicts proactively.
- New this year: <u>ABSENCE REQUEST FORM</u> This form MUST be submitted PRIOR to any missed rehearsal, practice or performance. IN addition to marching band, this form must be used for All Band rehearsals and performances: Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble and All Jazz Bands. When you are going to miss, just tell me. Not using this form will severely affect your class grade.

Excused Absences

- Submit the ABSENCE REQUEST FORM to the Director **prior** to the event for approval.
- In case of unavoidable emergencies, email, text or call the Director promptly.
- Timely notification allows for necessary adjustments.
- Work schedules, non-school activities, etc. are **not** acceptable excuses.
- Only unavoidable emergencies and illness will be considered excused absences.
- Please do not tell your friend to tell me you will be late/absent, etc. This is YOUR responsibility.

Discipline

- Each student is responsible for their actions as a band member.
- Alexandria City High School and Alexandria City Public Schools policies apply to all band activities.
- Violation of school rules may lead to school disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the band.

Rehearsals

- Rehearsals begin promptly at the stated time. Arrive early to prepare.
- "To be on-time is to be late"
- Rehearsals end promptly at the stated time.

Performances

- Marching Titans members are ambassadors for ACHS Bands, Alexandria City High School, and the community.
- Your behavior reflects on the entire organization.
- During football games, the band supports the team and engages the crowd throughout the entire game.
- Remain with the band during games; ask a staff member for permission to leave the stands.

Uniforms

- Wear the uniform/costume with pride, responsibility, and respect.
- You represent yourself, your family, your band, and your school while in uniform.
- Each member is responsible for the proper care of their assigned uniform/costume; financial responsibility applies to damage or loss.
- Follow the "all or nothing" uniform policy in public unless directed otherwise.
- Jackets must be fully zipped; hats worn facing forward with the brim in front.
- The 2025 ACHS marching band t-shirt is part of the uniform.
- No gum, food, or drinks (except water with permission) are allowed in uniform.
- No visible jewelry, earrings, or excessive makeup (except for color guard face makeup).
- Long hair must be pulled back and out of sight.
- Required Uniform Items (excluding color guard):
 - Clean, all-black socks (above the ankle, no patterns).
 - Black "Dinkles" marching shoes (purchased for \$30).

Summer Music Rehearsals

- Thursdays, July 17 and 24 6-8 pm.
- Purpose: Familiarize members with music, warm-ups, procedures, and build camaraderie before band camp.

August Rehearsals/Band Camp

- **TBD:** Begins for color guard, percussion, and section leaders.
- July 28 Aug 1, Aug 4-8 and Aug 11-14 Required for all Marching Titans members.
- These rehearsals are crucial for the season's foundation.

Attire (August Rehearsals)

• Wear athletic shoes with socks (no sandals, flip-flops, crocs, etc.).

- Dress for hot, humid weather (light-colored, loose-fitting shorts recommended).
- Hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen are advised.
- Rehearsals move indoors during inclement weather.

Meals (Band Camp)

- Students must bring their own lunch daily.
- ACHS is a closed campus; do not leave for lunch.

Water (Band Camp)

- Bring a large personal water bottle daily.
- Limit intake of carbonated beverages.

Equipment

- All students need their instruments/flags in good working order.
- Woodwinds: Reeds. Small screwdriver
- **Brass:** Valve/slide oil (slide lubricant for trombones).
- **Drumline:** Two pairs of matching, taped marching sticks in good condition.
- Color Guard: All practice flags, gloves, poles, and auxiliary equipment.
- Bring music (even if memorized) and UDB to every rehearsal.
- Report damage to school instruments immediately; students are financially responsible for damage due to negligence. Most damage is negligence.

Music Memorization

- Fight song, National Anthem, Chorale and show music **must** be memorized.
- Titles must be memorized by the first day of band camp (July 28)
- Seek help from section leaders, drum majors, or director if needed

Fundraisers

- Tag Day: Saturday, September 6, 2025, 8 am ~2 pm. All band members are required to participate.
- There are others throughout the year

Band Boosters Organization

- Meets the first Wednesday of each month.
- All parents are automatically members.
