Unit 4/Sensation and Perception: Interesting Sensory Experience Assignment

For this assignment, you may either choose a unique sensory experience you have over break (or one you remember from the past or have had recently), or consider your break as a whole. Try to choose a single incident if you can and consider the second choice (your whole break) as a backup.

Analyze what you were sensing and perceiving during this event by applying 10 bold terms from the reading. Include a variety from the chapter so that you include several of the senses and several perceptual terms. Since this chapter is stuffed with terms, you should easily (easily!) be able to find 10 different ones, so avoid using terms in the negative (i.e. "it's clear that I was NOT experiencing..." etc.). It should be clear that you've read and understand the chapter.

As always, please write in narrative form at a level that reflects that you're in an AP class, organize your response effectively, and be sure that your understanding of the terms is clear in how you apply them. Remember to be careful about using the real world meaning of the term, if it's also a common word. Please bold the terms as you use them.

Your final written response needs to be 1-2 typed, double spaced pages long and give enough description of the experience so that your use of terms makes sense.
