This one-page document is designed to be a reference sheet to help you select your courses for next year. Please refer to the Program of Studies for complete details.

Students in the Class of 2025 should make the following requests:

- **English IV** (C-Prep or Honors) **OR** AP Literature
- **Math: Any year-long (6 credit) math elective** or an **AP Math offering course** (prerequisites required)
- **Science: Any year-long (6 credit) science elective** **OR** an **AP Science offering** (prerequisites required)
- **Social Studies: Any year-long (6 credit) social studies elective** or an **AP Social Studies offering**
- **World Language:** Two years required if not in CTE
- **Health & Life Management**
- **CTE Program:** Choose Level III (If currently in Level II) All Level II CTE Programs are 12 credits.
- **Dual Enrollment:** Available in most subjects. See guidance counselor if interested

- **US History II: Action Civics** (C-Prep or Honors) or **AP US History**
- **World Language:** Select next level of **Spanish, French, or American Sign Language** (two years/levels required)
- **Physical Education**
- Choose Level II of **CTE Program** (If currently in Level I) | All Level II CTE Programs are 12 credits.
- **Dual Enrollment:** Available in most subjects. See guidance counselor if interested.
