Hearing Instructions (see official version on the <u>hearing webpage</u>):

- To give either **in-person or remote oral testimony**, use <u>the official</u> registration form.
 - o **Deadline for registering**: 4:00PM, Thursday Nov. 9.
 - o If you miss the deadline, you can sign-up at the hearing room on the day of the hearing and testify in person after all pre-registereds, *time permitting*.
- Individuals registered for **remote oral testimony** will receive an email the day after pre-registration closes with a link to join the hearing on Microsoft Teams.
- Individuals have **3 minutes** to testify.
- The form allows for **panels**. Each member of a panel fills out the pre-registration form separately and completely. The Chairs will permit either fully in-person panels or fully-remote panels only. Send questions related to panels to the Committee Director at timothy.oneill@mahouse.gov.
- Panels have? minutes.
- We ask oral testifiers to submit their testimony **in writing too**. The written version can be longer.

Written testimony:

- Individuals wishing to provide **written testimony only** do not fill out the registration form and have no deadline.
- Send written testimony to the Joint Committee Co-Chairs at <u>John.Lawn@mahouse.gov</u> and <u>Cindy.Friedman@masenate.gov</u> and the Committee Director at <u>timothy.oneill@mahouse.gov</u>. Please copy legislation@masscare.org. **This can be one email.**
- The Committee has no due date for written testimony. Please send it as soon as possible.

Odds & Ends:

- Oral testimony is usually first-registered/first-called. May be grouped by bill number, with our two bills in one group.
- The Committee and testifiers can see how many are registered (legislators, staff, and testifiers). They can't tell how many are just watching.
- Committee has until March 27 2024 to report bills out. If a favorable report, our bills would go next to Ways & Means, then Bills in 3rd Reading.
