6 Sheets Chart Instructions

After completing your 6 sheets we will use the data to begin to understand charting data and creating charts using Google Sheets. *15 Points*

Sheet 1 - Sales Rep Totals

- 1. Choose the range E2:E8
- Hold the control key down then select the range A2:A8
- 3. Click \rightarrow Insert \rightarrow Chart, the chart will appear on top of the data
- 4. Click on customize in the chart editor
- 5. Choose Chart & Axis Title Edit the title so it reads "Sales Rep Totals"
- 6. Click on the three dots located in the upper right corner of the chart(click on the chart to make the dots visible) → choose "Move to own sheet"
- 7. The chart then creates a new tab, rename the tab to "Sales Chart"

Sheet 2 Produce Sales

- 1. Choose the range B2:E8
- Hold the control key down then select the range A2:A8
- 3. Click → Insert → Chart, the chart will appear on top of the data. Make sure it is a **stacked column chart**. You find this in the chart type section in the chart editor.
- Click on customize in the chart editor
- 5. Choose Chart & Axis Title Edit the title so it reads "Fruit Sales for January, February, March, and April"
- 6. Click on the three dots located in the upper right corner of the chart(click on the chart to make the dots visible) → choose "Move to own sheet"
- 7. The chart then creates a new tab, rename the tab to "Fruit Chart"

Sheet 3 Mike's Stationery

- 1. Choose the range A2:A11
- Hold the control key down then select the range D2:D11
- Click → Insert → Chart, the chart will appear on top of the data. Make sure it is a column chart. You find this in the chart type section in the chart editor.
- 4. Click on customize in the chart editor
- 5. Choose Chart & Axis Title Edit the title so it reads "Sales Total by Item"

- 6. Change the series color in the editor to something **not blue**.
- 7. Click on the three dots located in the upper right corner of the chart(click on the chart to make the dots visible) → choose "Move to own sheet"
- 8. The chart then creates a new tab, rename the tab to "Stationary Chart"
