

Survey report on our school tuck shop,

Introduction

The Students Union recently conducted a survey to find out what students think about our school tuck shops. 324 S1 to S6 students submitted their questionnaires. This report describes the findings, conclusion and recommendation resulting from the survey finding.

A main finding was that a large majority of respondents went to the tuck shop frequently. Although 45.1% reported going to tuck shop 5 times or more per week, 1.5% reported they never went there. Students rated the food varieties offered and quality of service at 1.4 and 3.5 respectively on a 4-point scale.

Conclusion

In general, students often go to the tuck shop. Overall, the finding showed that our students were not satisfied with the variety of food on offer.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the tuck shop revise the lunch menus so that more healthy snacks such as fruit and vegetables can be offered to students.
