TPMGA BO LANGE MEMORIAL CLASSIC

The Bo Lange Memorial Classic (T)

Definition: The Classic is a tournament format made up of two-man teams consisting of six (6) different flights and three brackets. The field of players will be equally divided into flights and brackets ranging from the lowest handicap index to the highest.

Events: Singles, Team, and Skins **SCRATCH** two-day event against players within your flight and bracket.

- **Singles:** Each player will be playing against other players in their flight–stroke play (gross) total score for two days (same as the Timber Pointe club championship).
- **Team:** Each team will be playing against other teams in their bracket Best-ball-of-two (gross) total score for two days.
- **Skins:** Team skins by bracket (gross) each day. You will be playing for skins only against those teams in your bracket. Since this is a team event, players cannot cut each other if they both score the same.

YOU MUST PLAY EVERY HOLE AND COUNT EVERY STROKE - - - NO PICK-UPS

If a **competitor** fails to hole out at any hole and does not correct his mistake before he makes a **stroke** on the next **teeing ground** or, in the case of the last hole of the round, before he leaves the **putting green**, he is disqualified.

ALL PUTTS MUST BE HOLED OUT - - - NO "GIMMES"

All play is in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf except where modified within the TPMGA Supplementary Rules Sheet.

Handicap: SCRATCH

Tee Box:

Flight A	Blue Tees
Flights B, C & D	White Tees
Flight E	Silver Tee
Flight F	Red Tees

Advice: During a **stipulated round**, a player may give or ask for **advice** from his partner and not from anyone in the competition playing on the **course** other than his **partner**.

Scoring: All Score cards must be signed by the Scorer and Attested by the opponent team. Once the cards are signed and submitted the scores will be posted and there will be NO CHANGES.

In the event of a tie score **Singles** – cards will be matched by using the combined score of handicap 1 hole #3 day one and day two. If still tied the combined score of handicap 2 hole #18 day one and day two, and so on and so forth until a winner is established. **Note: the TMPGA scorecards will be used for tiebreakers!**

In the event of a tie score **Team** – cards will be matched by using <u>both players'</u> combined score of handicap 1 hole #3 day one and day two. If still tied <u>both players</u> combined score of handicap 2 hole #18 day one and day two, and so on and so forth until a winner is established. **Note: the TMPGA scorecards will be used for tiebreakers!**

Handicap Index: Players USGA Chicago District handicap index as of May 26, 2024 will be used to flight players.

NOTE: (T) Indicates tournament score posting

Rain-out:

- If there is a rain-out of any of the days the winning Team will be based upon which Team has the best score at the end of the Saturday matches or Sunday if Saturday is rained out. If both days are rained out the tournament will be rescheduled at a later date.
- Under USGA Rules 33-1 and 33-2d, the Committee can cancel the first and second rounds if the entire field does not finish 18 holes. However, if the entire field completes nine holes each day the Committee can declare the leader after 18 holes (9 holes each day) or 27 holes (9 holes one day and 18 holes the other day) to be the winner.

Entry Fee: TPMGA Members \$60 per player

Pay Outs: Subject to the number of players participating with flight and bracket winners plus team skins (if no skins on day one the pot will roll over to day two and if no skins on day two the pot will roll over to day one.)
