## VCA Health Guidelines 2021-2022



## **Symptoms Screening:**

- Staying home when symptomatic is essential to keep all infections out of our school and prevent spread to others. This will be monitored closely.
- Occurrence of any of the symptoms below while a student, teacher, or staff member is at school suggests the individual will be sent home and may be referred for physician evaluation.
- Most common symptoms that have the potential to be contagious:

Fever (temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher)

Sore throat

Unusual Fatigue

Congestion

Persistent Cough (for people with chronic cough due to allergies or asthma, a change in their cough from baseline)

New loss of taste or smell

Diarrhea or vomiting

New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever

## **Diagnosed with Covid-19 or presumed to have Covid-19:**

- Please email school nurse for communication
- Remain home at least 5 days since the 1st day of symptoms
- May return on day 6 and wear a mask through day 10.
- Negative test not required to return to school
