## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Stadium Seating

Seating Capacity

Total: 10,134

Home Side: 5,039

Visitor Side: 5,095

Wheelchair accessibility and viewing available on both home and visitor side

### Playing Surface

The Pflugerville field is equipped with a Hellas-Matris Turf artificial playing surface and Cushdrain impact pad that provide a safe playing surface for all sports in all weather conditions.

### Playing Field

- Sideline passes will be provided to the head coach or assigned individual upon arrival at the stadium. Sideline passes must be visible for individuals not wearing a uniform or directly connected to the team
- Only emergency vehicles will be parked in the stadium. No vehicles or heavy loads are allowed on the field
- Gum, sunflower seeds, peanuts, candy-colored drinks, and similar products are not allowed on the field
- Confetti and baby powder are prohibited
- Sharp wheels or edges on equipment are prohibited. In addition, band props must not damage the field surface
- Spectators are not allowed in the playing field before, during, or after game time
- Blow-up spirit helmets and tunnels are permitted
- PfISD provides benches, tables, water cows, and ice chests for the side line
- Victory lines will be limited to school-sponsored groups on the field
- Visiting teams to the PfISD Stadium will be held responsible for damages to the playing field

### Press Box

- The press box is 4,631 square feet with an elevator
- An area for both home and visitor radio is available
- Will open to coaches 2 hours prior to game time (if needed)
- Access to the press box and elevator will be through the entrance marked "Press Box"
- Admittance is by pass only
  - o Media Personnel: Must reserve spots prior to the game by filling out our PfISD [Media Form](#) located on the PfISD athletics website
  - o Three to four scouts from the next opponent for each team will be allowed in the press box

### Restrooms

- Restroom facilities are located by each concession stand area

### Scoreboard & Sound System

- The stadium features a 40' x 64' video display
- The scoreboard has a high-resolution instant replay/images screen
- The stadium has a state-of-the-art 1500 HD sound system designed to provide high impact sound reinforcement for a variety of outdoor events

### Dressing Rooms

- One home side dressing room
- One visitor side dressing room
- There are separate coaches' offices and training rooms in each dressing room
- Only authorized personnel will be allowed in the area before, during, and after game
- Decorating the locker rooms is not allowed
- Towels are not provided by PfISD
- PfISD is not responsible for articles left in the dressing rooms

### Entrances

Two entry gates open into the Stadium facility; two enter from Pecan Street and one from Swenson Farms Blvd. These entry points will also double as main exits from the stadium after all events.

### Gates

- Gates will open 1 hour prior to game time for spectators.
- Home gates are located on the west side of the stadium and visitor gates on the east side.
- There are no refunds, rain checks, or exchanges for tickets
- No in/out privileges. A new ticket must be purchased to re-enter the stadium
- Due to security concerns, backpacks and handbags may be searched

### Bleachers

- There will be no climbing or jumping over the rails from the bleachers to the field
- Loitering is not allowed. Spectators must remain in the stands and away from the rails. For security reasons, aisles must remain clear at all times. Students are not allowed to cross to the other side of the stadium
- Signs and banners must promote school teams and programs and not include negative comments about opposing teams
- Vinyl signs are allowed and can be zip-tied to the rails, and after game, zip-ties and signs must be removed
- Water-based painted signs are not allowed
- Visitors can place their signs on the visitor bleacher side only
- Home team can place their signs on the home bleacher side only
- Signs cannot be taped to rails or placed on any stadium structures/surfaces

## Concession Stands

- Three concession stands are located at the corners of the stadium

## Parking

- The stadium has 2,000 parking spaces and every available spot will be used in order to accommodate visitors. Additional parking is located adjacent to the stadium
- Bus parking is available for team and support groups. Please refer to the map at the end of this guide for specific parking areas

## GENERAL FACILITY

- Firearms are not allowed
- Alcoholic beverages and controlled substances are prohibited. State law and school district policies will be enforced
- Tobacco products and smoking are prohibited inside and outside the stadium, including electronic cigarettes and vapes
- Coolers are not allowed
- Service animals only
- Outside food and drink are not allowed in the stadium
- Glass containers are prohibited in the stadium and parking lot areas
- Items requiring detailed clean-up, such as confetti, powder, balloons, etc. are not permitted
- Cannons, shirt cannons train horns, whistles, or any other loud noisemakers are not permitted
- Small hand-held noisemakers will be permitted at the discretion of the PfISD Athletic Department
- Sound systems will not be permitted in the stadium
- Open flames, space heaters, flaming batons, gas generators, smoke grenades or pyrotechnics cannot be used in the facility
- No product(s) may be sold outside or inside the stadium UNLESS with advanced and approved notice from the PfISD Athletic Director

- Crossing over to the opponents side of the stadium is not allowed unless you have proper credentials

PfISD reserves the right to prohibit any objects brought into the stadium

# CLEAR BAG POLICY

As an effort to improve safety and security, beginning August 2019 a clear bag policy will be enforced for all PfISD athletic home events at The PFIELD sports complex. 
## APPROVED BAGS

### LARGE BAGS


To bring bags to an athletic event at The PFIELD, bags must be clear and not exceed 12 in. (by 6 in. by 12 in.) or be a clear one-gallon resealable plastic storage bag. One per person.

Bags must be clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and have a maximum of one logo imprint not exceeding 4.5 in. tall x 3.4 in. wide.




### CLEAR BRANDED BAGS

### SMALL BAGS

The only non-clear bags permitted are small bags (with or without a strap) no larger than the size of a hand.



Exceptions to the clear bag policy will be made for credentialed media and those with necessary medical items after proper inspection at designated areas.

# METAL DETECTOR POLICY/PROCEDURE

Pflugerville Independent School District is committed to ensuring a safe environment by protecting the health, safety, and welfare of all students, staff, and visitors of **The Pfield Stadium**. Persons that do not consent to a metal detection screening may be denied admittance. The metal detector checks shall be neutral and non-discriminatory. No person shall be selected to be searched based solely upon his/her gender, race, ethnicity, religion, disability, physical appearance, manner of dress, or association with any particular group of persons.

## **TO COMBAT SCHOOL VIOLENCE AND THE POTENTIAL PRESENCE OF WEAPONS IN OUR FACILITIES, PFLUGERVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY UTILIZE METAL DETECTORS TO DETECT FIREARMS, KNIVES, AND OTHER WEAPONS.**

- ✓ Spectators who seek admission into the facility must first proceed to the metal detector screening area.
- ✓ Stadium Staff will instruct spectators on how to enter the metal detectors and guide them through the entrance. Spectators will be instructed to empty the metal contents of their pockets and carry them through the metal detector above their head.
- ✓ If the metal detector alarm sounds while being screened in any areas besides the “above the head” signal, the spectator will have the opportunity to empty the contents of the area in question and the spectator will be wand-screened. The hand-held scanning device should be passed along the front, back, and both sides of the person being scanned without touching the body.
- ✓ If the hand-held scanning device also activates, the law enforcement official or principal or designee will ask the spectator once again to produce the signal-triggering metal object.
- ✓ Any illegal objects (i.e., firearms, knives, or other implements which can be used as weapons) found during the search will be turned over to law enforcement officials.
- ✓ Spectators who refuse cooperation will be denied access into the facility.

The presence of metal detectors provides the community, parents, and staff with a sense of security when they know everyone in the facility has been screened. Providing a safe environment allows spectators to enjoy the game and feel safe.

## PLAYOFF GAMES

### Pflugerville ISD Provides

- Police and Security
- Stadium Manager
- Ticket takers and gate keepers
- Announcer and spotter
- Press box elevator attendants and greeters on each floor of the press box
- Dressing rooms for each team
- Payment for all game expenses and preparation of financial report to be provided within ten working days following the event
- Event Wristbands for different levels of stadium access (pick up at the field house at arrival)
  - o 10 tunnel crew wristbands allow pregame and beginning of 3<sup>rd</sup> qrt access
  - o 10 Press box access for school VIPs
  - o 25 Field Access for the entire game. Should include ball boys
  - o 30 Coach VIP Post game access
- Players, Managers, Student Athletic Trainers, Cheerleaders, Coaches, Athletic Trainers, and Sponsors will not need wristbands.

### Competing Schools will

- Secure game officials, **including chain crew and clock operators**
- Review, sign, and return playoff agreement
- Email PfISD Athletics a list of “Press Box Personnel”
- Email PfISD Athletics a copy of all approved passes to be honored at ticket booths on game night (THSCA, district passes, etc.)
- Game programs and program sellers
- Email PfISD Athletics a team roster prior to game day
