

# IMPORTANT DUAL ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

The application will open on September 2, 2025 and will close on October 2, 2025

PERT scores/ Other Test Scores are due November 7, 2025

**\*It is the applicant's responsibility to take the PERT test on time!**

The application is done online. **You can schedule an appointment with Mrs. Hearn to help you with your application.**

To qualify you **need a 3.0 high school GPA**. Students can take up to 4 classes per semester if they are Full Time Dual Enrollment. Students can take classes during the day, at night, or online. If you were to take classes during the day you would need transportation to get to Valencia. The credits count toward both your high school transcript as well as your college degree.

You must pass the PERT to get into Valencia Dual Enrollment, PERT is a placement test through Valencia. You can go to Valencia and get study guides for about \$5.00 per pack. If you have any questions about the upcoming application process, feel free to contact the office for more information.

## **HOW TO APPLY**

**Step 1:** The student will visit [valenciacollege.edu/dual](http://valenciacollege.edu/dual) and click on "Apply Now" to create a login and submit the online Dual Enrollment application.

**Step 2:** Look for an email titled "Get Started on your Valencia College Application" – make sure to double check your spam/junk folders for it. Select "Create Password" and follow the instructions to create a new password. Make sure to write down your username and password!

**Step 3:** Select "Start a New Application". Select "Yes" for "Are you currently in high school and looking to participate in the Dual Enrollment program?". Select the application term. Click on "Start Application". Provide all the requested information and select "Submit your application". Verify, sign, and select "verify and Submit".

**Step 4:** After submitting the student portion of the application, make sure your parent/guardian completes their approval form by the application deadline for your application to be considered. Once the DE school representative provides academic verification, the application will be finalized and sent to the Dual Enrollment office. A confirmation email will be sent to the student's email once all signatures are provided. The student will receive an email with their Valencia ID number (VID) five business days after application completion. If the student has previously applied, their VID will remain the same.

- Taking the PERT at the Valencia Assessment Center:
  - o Student must submit a DE application and receive a VID number.
  - o Students is required to take VID, and a state or federally issued picture ID (i.e., driver's license or passport) to the Assessment Center to test on a walk-in basis, no appointment needed. If the students does not have a state or federally issued form of ID, an original birth certificate or a social security card along with a school ID can be accepted.
  - o DE students can take the PERT three times at Valencia in a two-year period. No fee is required for the first attempt. Two retakes per sub-test are allowed; you must wait at least 24 hours to retake, attend a Valencia College retake review session and pay \$10 per sub-test. Scores from other college institutions will not be accepted. For more information, visit the [assessment website](#).
  - o If using SAT or ACT scores please note that there is a 5 week processing time.
