

Google Slides Level 2 Creator Badge Requirements

Holders of this badge have demonstrated an advanced ability to use Google Slides for creating presentations. The earner completed approximately 2 hours of professional learning credit equal to 2 CLU's to earn this badge.

- 1. Create a new Google Slides presentation and upload a free education-themed template from the web. Delete all but 3 of the slides. Paste the URL from where you got the template below.
- 2. Import slides 2 -6 from the slideshow at bit.ly/BFEpresentation so they are now your new presentation's slides 4-8. Number the slides if they are not already numbered. Make them change to your new educational theme. Make your slide presentation viewable by anyone with the link and copy and past the link below.
- 3. Make slide 4 (Life Cycles) more professional by inserting one of Google's Diagrams. Take a screenshot and upload or paste a link to it below.
- 4. On slide 5 (with the table), add a column to the left of the teacher column for "Date". Add a row above the first row in the table for a title. Merge the 4 cells across and name it "Teacher Workshop Sign-in" (center it).
- 5. On slide 6 (with the rosette badge), Arrange the 3 images in the bottom half of the slide to look similar to the example. Add a white square background like the one in the example, then group them so they can be moved as a unit.
- 6. On slide 7 (with quote), double space the lines. What font is used for the quote? On slide 8 (with website screenshot), crop the image so only the quote remains.
- 7. Add a 9th slide and write your name in cursive using the line "scribble" selection tool. Make a heart shape using the line "curve" selection tool.
- 8. Add a 10th slide and create a poll with Poll Everywhere to insert.
- 9. Add the Add-On "Icons By Noun Project" and one other of your choosing. Explain why Add-Ons are useful and why you chose the Add-on that you did.
