- Write your conclusion at home (ONLY the introduction and conclusion are done at home).
- Exchange with someone to have it peer edited
- Peer edit someone's at home and return to them the next day

Day 5: (Thursday)

- Bring in rough drafts to be checked off by the teacher (that's me!)
- Complete your good copy at home and bring in as a hard copy
