Responsibilities

The Editor-in-Chief is responsible for the <u>large-scale vision of JIPP</u>. This includes managing staff and authors, selecting topics for quarterly issue publications, selecting solicitations from team members for publications, and outreach with other organizations for collaboration and growth. For more granular operations, including most primary edits, the Editor-in-Chief relies on JIPP staff. However, some of the more high-level operations must be ensured by the Editor-in-Chief or properly delegated, including formatting of publications, final posting to the Blog, and managing social media presence.

Expected time commitment should not exceed 5 hours a week. The role is not currently compensated.

Qualifications

The Editor-in-Chief position must be a young person, although we do not restrict applicants based on any education level. (High school, undergrad, postgrad, etc. are all accepted). Applicants are also accepted from across the globe. Strong applicants will have

- Strong policy backgrounds across many fields of domestic and international policy.
- Experience managing teams larger than 20 people.
- Strong command of English writing, including grammar, rhetoric, and academic rigor.
- Published (or otherwise written) policy research papers, demonstrating mastery of research frameworks and citation styles.

Please note that JIPP is a nonpartisan organization. Candidates are preferred to not have explicit partisan affiliations, but this is not a mandatory requirement. Candidates with partisan affiliations must commit to a clear separation of JIPP and their other role/organization.
