## **Information for the day**

### **Saturday 21st March**

Fareham Live – Main entrance

**Registration will begin at 9am**

**Auditions will begin at 10am**

We are expecting a lot of interest so please do allow us time to get everyone registered and start the day with us.

**Auditions will finish at 12pm**

**Call backs will commence at 1pm**

You will be notified during the morning if you are required to return and will finish at 3pm

**A parent/ guardian MUST remain on site whilst their child auditions. You will remain responsible for your child during their time in the venue. Our cafe will be open during this time for drinks and snacks.**

## **What we need from you**

- You will need a passport-style photo PRINTED size 6x4 inches (only the auditionee should be in the photo, with a plain background)  
**Without a photo you will not be able to take part in auditions!**
- Please bring a water bottle and a few light snacks

- Turn up with a great attitude and dressed ready to learn a short movement piece, a song and lines

### **What to expect on the day**

- You will be registered and given a number, then divided up into two groups to learn movement and a song. Once you are back in the main space you will perform these in smaller groups.
- Call backs will be given at the end of this session.
- Call backs will start at 1pm. During this session you will take part in a workshop using characters and sections of the script
- This session will finish 3pm
- Character call backs and second round of auditions will be held on 30<sup>th</sup> April
