



The electrification of politics at a local level has been something chased after by both the Republicans and Democrats, but neither party has seen much success. The Socialists, despite claiming to be the party of public revolution, have seen even less success than the parties to which they are subordinate. But one candidate is blazing the trail for what it means to retain grassroots support.

Former Secretary of Defense Chris Frost is running for the Senate in Lincoln's special election. Once a Democrat, Frost has since denounced the party that had once refused him equal membership. Now, as a member of the upstart Civics People's Party, Secretary Frost is paying selective Chairperson Leaven Silva back in folds as public support for him overflows.

This public support has manifested itself in local party branches and citizens voicing their support for the Secretary. In Minnesota, Lincoln, the Reform Party of Minnesota has endorsed Chris Frost for the Senate seat he's pining after.

But this support doesn't just stop at a simple three-sentence statement and a few picket signs. The Reform Party has gone so far as to [set up a Patreon account](#) for the would-be Senator.

When pressed for comment, the Chair of the Reform Party of Minnesota, Grant Ulysses, provided us with the following;

I think, and we as a whole think, that the Democrats are a sham. Since 2015, they've been against money in politics, but where has there [sic] efforts against Citizens United been? They're just bringing in the money against these candidates that can't field as much funds. And we've had enough of the hypocrisy. That's why we decided to set up a grassroots funding page for Chris Frost, so he can stand a chance against the big money that the Dems claim to fight against but really just utilize. I think it's high time that, instead of fighting for third trimester abortions and government control of the economy, we fight for the stuff we really believe in.

The Reform Party isn't the only organization—or individuals, rather—looking to make a change in the political landscape. Seventeen year old George McLellan of Chicago, Lincoln has [created a GoFundMe on behalf of the Frost campaign](#). While the minor declined to comment on his decision, he has taken to social media to express his support for the Senate candidate, as seen below.
