



Help us understand vaccine concerns in your community!

Introduction

We are inviting you to be a member of a patient advisory board to provide input on content for an online COVID-19 vaccine counseling training module for community pharmacists. This sheet is to give you key information to help you decide whether to participate.

About the study

We are conducting a research study involving a COVID-19 vaccine hesitancy counseling intervention for rural community pharmacists. Pharmacists will be trained to implement the intervention and will be provided with support tools, such as an online training module that includes common patient concerns about the COVID-19 vaccine and example responses for pharmacists. COVID-19 and our understanding of it is ever-changing. As a result, COVID-19 vaccine recommendations and patient concerns rapidly change. We are seeking four rural pharmacy patients to serve on an advisory board to help update our list of vaccine concerns and suggested ways to respond to concerns on a monthly basis.

Who we are seeking

A total of 4 patients who go to rural pharmacies, 2 who identify as Black and 2 who identify as Republican.

Expectations

The patient advisory board will meet with the study team for 30-45 minutes a month for up to 18 months. At each meeting, patients will share what concerns they have heard about the COVID-19 vaccine that month and suggestions they have for how pharmacists can address these concerns. **You must have reliable internet access to serve on the advisory board.**

Compensation

Each patient advisory board member will receive \$50 per meeting for up to 18 meetings.
