Subject: 2024 AGM Decision O10 Regarding Sale of the HRAC

Dear Helen and Andrew,

I am writing this letter on behalf of xxx local group/network regarding the decision by the AIUK Section Board to ignore the decision made at the 2024 AIUK AGM where Resolution O10 was passed, calling for the delay to the sale of the Human Rights Action Centre until there has been a full and transparent consultation with the membership of AIUK, with all options voted on at an AIUK AGM.

Following the Watford Group's meetings with both of you, it is clear that the Section do indeed have a say in the decisions made by the Charitable Trust. Andrew Lines said in this meeting that if the Section were to express any desire to delay the sale or rethink the decision then they would reconsider.

This is contrary to what the Section Board has been saying in their "Implementation of AGM resolutions - September 2024" update.

We are therefore asking once again for you to:

Immediately take the HRAC off the market

Begin the process for a full and transparent consultation about the future of the HRAC with the AIUK membership

Have all options as a result of that consultation be voted on at an AIUK AGM Respect and implement the results of 2024 AGM Decision O10
