

8th Grade Dance

NO CELL PHONES

- *Students will place their cell phones in a cell phone basket when they check in*

DATE: Friday, May 15

TIME: 7:00pm - 9:00pm

Please do not arrive prior to 7:00pm

Please pick up your 8th grader no later than 9:00pm

LOCATION: Dining Hall and possibly the outside patio (weather permitting)

Enter the building through the main lobby doors

COST: \$5 per student (**cash**)

DRESS CODE: comfortable and appropriate for a dance

Girls:

- You are allowed to wear strapless or spaghetti strap dresses. (However, remember that you will be dancing all evening, and if you wear a strapless dress, you will be pulling it up all night!)
- Your stomach and back (from the bra strap down) need to be covered.
 - No midriff cutouts.
- Length of your dress/skirt is the same as the school dress code-fingertip length.
- No cleavage should be showing.
- We should not be able to see any parts of your undergarments (including straps)
- High heels are great, but you also might want to bring tennis shoes because your feet will get sore!

Boys:

- Shorts are allowed, but must be the same length as allowed in school.
- No compression shorts are to show.
- We should not be able to see any parts of your undergarments
- No tank tops or cut-off shirts. Your shirt needs to have at least short sleeves.
- If you wear a button down shirt, the buttons need to stay buttoned (up to normal height) throughout the dance.

Rules

- Students show up with a super positive and fun spirit.

 - No going down to level three other than the lobby on their way home.
 - Use common sense for the rest of the rules
