- 1. **Headline:** The headline does not build intrigue or curiosity. Should be changed into a fascination.
- 2. Lack of Human Touch: Other than the video, there is not much emotionality in the sales page. No pain points or desires being amplified. It is dry to read. Can include a lead section right after the video to emotionally connect with the reader. Ask a few directed rhetorical questions to amplify the pain points, introduce the solution, then introduce our offer as the best way to use the solution to solve the problem. Can also use a short story.
- 3. **Benefits vs Features:** Only the features of the program are stated. Should focus more on the benefits of these features and the outcome they will help the student get.
- 4. **Jargon:** Can explain some of the Jargon words used at the beginning of the page (Khatma).
- 5. **Personal Connection with Teacher:** For the Teacher's qualifications, can include a personal anecdote or a story of their journey to build an emotional connection with the reader.
- 6. **Not enough CTA Buttons:** Not enough CTA buttons in the page. Should have one after every section of the page.
- 7. **Unclear Value Proposition:** Can move the "What is included" section right next to the price, just to help the customer understand the value they will be receiving.
- 8. **Reverse risk:** Can offer a 2 week money back guarantee to reverse risk.
- Clear CTA Sentence + Scarcity: Need to have a clear CTA sentence right above the Buttons in the Price & Class Time sections. It should include scarcity (Maximum 5 students).
