

POINT FOUNDATION: COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR LGBT STUDENTS

Award: \$2,000 - \$4,800

Deadline: Typically closes in January

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled or intending to enroll at an accredited college or university based in the United States in the fall of 2021. Students enrolled or intending to enroll in a college or university in a United States territory are not eligible.
- Must be “out” as a person who identifies as a member of the LGBTQ community.
- Must be enrolled full-time for the full academic year and at least a senior in high school.
- Must enroll in a degree-granting undergraduate or graduate/ doctoral program. Post-doctoral research programs are not eligible.
- Community college students must be transferring to a four-year college or university.
- Must be at least a senior in high school.
- If selected as a finalist, the finalist must be able to record a video for the Point Selections Committee. More details provided to those who reach the finalist stage.

Award: Varies

Requirements:

- Must be a graduating senior entering higher education for the first time in the current calendar year.
- Must self-identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer or anywhere within the LGBTQ “family,” or as an ally.
- Must demonstrate an interest in service to the LGBTQ community.
- Must have applied to an accredited U.S. higher education institution. Cannot be receiving full-tuition remission sources to fund the education (e.g., other full-tuition scholarships, established college trust fund, etc.).
