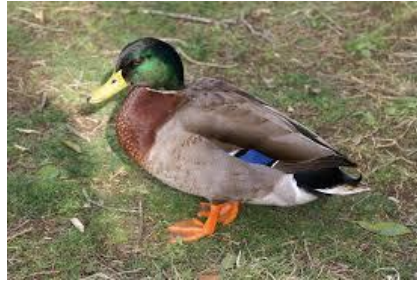


Red billed tern
