Leyte Normal University (LNU) continues to strengthen its institutional mechanisms to support students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds through a range of scholarship and assistance programs. These programs are designed to help students from low-income families pursue higher education, participate in co-curricular engagements, and access opportunities that contribute to their academic and personal development.

In **2023**, the university offered **26 scholarship and student assistance programs** catering to learners in need. By **2024**, the number of available programs stood at **24**, reflecting a slight decrease due to adjustments in funding allocations and program realignments. Despite this reduction, LNU remains steadfast in providing meaningful and diverse forms of support to ensure that no student is left behind due to financial limitations.

Through these sustained programs and collaborations, LNU demonstrates its unwavering commitment to ensuring that education remains an accessible and empowering pathway for all students, particularly those from low-income households.

QUALIFICATIONS & CRITERIA SELECTION

- Must be a 2nd year college student at the time of application
- Must belong to an indigent or economically challenged family
- Must have a General Weighted Average (GWA) of at least 2.25 (82%) with no failing grade and incomplete grade in any subject
- Student applicants must pass the interview and agree to a home visitation to be conducted by the social worker in-charge, staff, and volunteers of the Tzu Chi Foundation
- Must be a resident of Palo and Tacloban, Leyte

Assistance and Support Programs for Students from Low-Income Families

Leyte Normal University (LNU) remains steadfast in its mission to provide equitable access to quality education by implementing various programs and services that address the diverse needs of its students, particularly those from low-income families. These initiatives—ranging from financial aid to health, food, and housing support—aim to reduce poverty in all its forms and ensure that every student has the opportunity to succeed academically and personally.

Financial Assistance Programs

The **Loan Assistance Program for Students (LAPS)** is a financial support initiative designed to assist students in paying their tuition fees, particularly during the Midterm Examinations, when financial aid from home may not yet have arrived. Students can borrow funds to cover tuition costs, with repayment due on or before the Final Examinations. Loans settled within the same month incur no interest, while those paid beyond that period are charged a minimal monthly interest. This system ensures that temporary financial setbacks do not disrupt students' education, fostering equal learning opportunities for all.

The **Student Assistantship Program** complements this financial support by allowing qualified students to work within various university offices while pursuing their studies. Student assistants render services for a set number of hours each week and receive compensation to help sustain their educational expenses. Applicants must have at least one year of residence at LNU, maintain a GPA of at least 2.5, and possess good moral character, diligence, and good health. The program develops students' work ethic, discipline, and time management skills—traits that prepare them for future employment—while easing their financial burdens.

Health and Wellness Services

LNU recognizes that good health is vital to effective learning and academic performance. The **Medical and Dental Services** unit ensures students' physical and mental well-being through routine health examinations, medical consultations, treatment of minor illnesses, and emergency care. The clinic also assesses students' fitness for participation in sports and other physical activities. Dental services, including oral prophylaxis, tooth extraction, and filling, are provided on an appointment basis or during emergencies. By promoting preventive care and health awareness, LNU safeguards students' well-being, reducing the impact of medical expenses on their financial stability.

Nutritional Support Services

The **Food Services** program, offered through the LNU Cafeteria and the LNU Credit and Consumers' Cooperative, provides nutritious yet affordable meals and snacks to the university community. Operating on a self-service system, the cafeteria encourages responsibility, courtesy, and orderliness among students while serving as a laboratory for Home Economics and food management courses. This service ensures that

The **Dormitory** offers safe, affordable, and convenient housing to students, particularly those coming from distant areas. Admission is on a first-come, first-served basis, ensuring fairness in access. Dormitory life fosters values such as respect for others, discipline, time management, and personal hygiene—skills essential for responsible adulthood and professional life. By providing accessible accommodation, LNU helps minimize the financial strain of daily travel or external housing costs for students from low-income families.

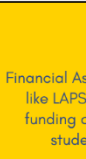
Leyte Normal University is dedicated to supporting students from low-income families through a variety of **assistance programs** designed to foster academic success and personal well-being.

Financial Assistance Programs like LAPS provide crucial funding opportunities for students in need.

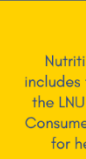
Health and Wellness Services ensure access to medical and dental care for all students.
